- 1 The aforesaid Audited Standalone/ Consolidated financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board at its meeting held on 11th May, 2019.
- 2 The figures for the Quarter ended 31st March, 2019 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the 3rd Quarter of the Current financial year.
- 3 The Company has prepared Consolidated Financial Results on annual basis for Consolidation of financial statement of Mayfair Investment Holding PTE. LTD., Joint Venture with the Company.
- The Board at its meeting on 22nd March,2019 approved a proposal to buyback upto 23,25,000 fully paid- up equity shares of face value of Rs 10/- each from the eligible equity shareholders of the Company for a total consideration of Rs. 26,73,75,000 crores on proportionate basis through "Tender Offer" Route. The Buyback offer comprised a purchase of 23,25,000 Equity Shares aggregating 24.99% of the paid- up equity share capital of the Company. Necessary approval from the Shareholders have been obtained. Further, The letter of Offer shall be shortly submitted to SEBI for its approval on the same.
- 5 This Statement has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) as amended by the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) (Amended) Rules, 2016 as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
- The format for audited/un-audited results as prescribed in SEBI's Circular CIR/CFD/CMD/15/2015 dated November 30, 2015 has been modified to the extent required to comply with requirements of SEBI's circular dated July 5, 2016, ind AS and Schedule III (Division II) to the Companies Act, 2013 applicable to Companies that are required to comply with Ind AS.
- The Statutory Auditors have carried out Audit on the aforesaid standalone financial results for the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2019 and for the consolidated financial results for the year ended 31st March, 2019, provided however that the standalone financial results, pertaining to corresponding quarter and year ended March, 2018 and the consolidated financial results for the year ended 31st March, 2018 has been carried out by the erstwhile auditors of the Company.
- 8 The Statutory Auditors have carried out Audit on the aforesaid financial results and have expressed an unqualified audit opinion.
- 9 The company operates mainly in one business segment viz. cultivation, manufacturing and selling of Tea being reportable segment and all other activities revolve around the main activity.
- 10 Previous year/ period figures have been regrouped/rearranged, wherever necessary to make them comparable with the current period figures.
