Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Clause no. 20 of Para A of Part A of Schedule III of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 (“**SEBI Circular**”), this is to inform that the Company is in receipt of judgment dated 16th May 2024 passed by the Court of First Instance(Commercial - Dubai Court) where it has ordered the Company to pay the RSM General Trading – *erstwhile distributor of the Company for Middle East and Africa markets for the duration 30th July 2020 till 17th January 2023 (“Plaintiff”)* an amount of AED 25,071,991/- as compensation for the damages along with legal interest at a rate of 5% (from the date the judgment becomes final until full payment is made) and AED 1,000 as attorney fees in favour of RSM General Trading.

The details of the orders, as required under Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI Circular dated July 13, 2023, is enclosed herewith as an Annexure – 1.

Accordingly, the Company is in process of filing an appeal before Court of Appeal (Dubai), challenging the judgment passed by the Court of First instance.</p> <p>In view of the above, the Company does not expect this Judgment to have any material financial impact.</p>
