Opinion

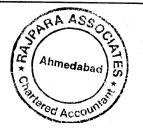

The report has been filed with the stock exchanges and is available on the Company's website at "www.drcsystems.com".
- In accordance with Ind AS-108 "Operating Segments" and evaluation by the Chief Operating Decision Maker, the Company operates in one business segment i.e. IT and IT enabled Services including web and mobile app development, maintenance, testing and related ancillary services, which is reflected in the above results.
- The Board of Directors approved the issue of 2 (Two) Bonus Equity Shares for every 1 (One) Equity Share held by the Equity Shareholders of the Company as on "Record Date" out of share premium account of the Company available as on March 31, 2023. The Bonus Issue of Equity Shares was approved by the shareholders in their EGM held on February 15, 2024. The "Record Date" was fixed as February 27, 2024 for determining the eligible shareholders entitled to receive Bonus Shares. The Bonus Equity Shares were alloted on February 29, 2024 and the trading approval for the same was received on March 06, 2024. These bonus shares are ranking pari-passu in all respects and carry the same rights as that of the existing equity shares.

Accordingly, as per the IndAS 33 - Earning per Share, the calculation of basic and diluted earnings per share for all periods/year presented have been adjusted retrospectively.

- The standalone figures of the last quarter are the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year upto March 31, 2024 and March 31, 2023 and the unaudited year-to-date figures upto December 31, 2023 and December 31, 2022 respectively being the date of the end of the third quarter of the financial year which were subjected to limited review.
- The figures for comparative period/year have been regrouped/ reclassified, wherever necessary, to make them comparable.

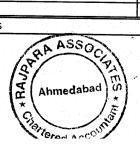

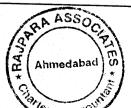

- Company's revenue from operations was INR 1712 Lacs during the quarter, up 153 % Y-o-Y primarily due to strong revenue growth witnessed international markets.
- Revenue from operations for the full year FY'24 period grew 86% Y-o-Y from INR 2563 Lacs to INR 4768 Lacs.
