Digital news startup The Messenger to lay off about 24 employees

San Francisco, Jan 3 (IANS) Digital news startup The Messenger is reportedly laying off about 24 employees amid severe cash crunch, as its president Richard Beckman has announced to leave the company.

The employees were likely to be laid off this week as part of a cost-cutting measure, reports The New York Times, citing sources.

"The company is facing financial headwinds in a tough digital ad market that have put a squeeze on its operations," said the report.

The Messenger said in a statement that it was "in the midst of a second-round raise".

However, the startup, which has nearly 300 employees, did not reveal the number of people it has laid off.

The Messenger publishes articles on politics, culture and general-interest news. Meanwhile, Beckman, a former executive at Conde Nast, who

served as The Messenger's president, announced that he was leaving the company, citing "short-term health issues".

Prior to The Messenger's launch, Beckman had claimed that the website would generate more than \$100 million in revenue in 2024 with 100 million monthly readers.

Veteran media executive Jimmy Finkelstein started The Messenger last year.

In a post on LinkedIn, Beckman said that he told Finkelstein in November that he would be stepping down on January 31 but would remain an investor in the company. "Back in November I had advised Jimmy Finkelstein of my decision to step down based on short term health issues I have endured this past year and will be subsequently retiring from the corporate world at the end of this month," he wrote, adding that he will be "helping with the transition" in the next few weeks.--IANS

annually on their smartphones and till now, consumers have largely adapted to an app-driven world.

"With the rise of AI, smartphones are transforming to intelligent at-tuned digital companions. In 2024 and beyond, AI will increasingly integrate

seamlessly as a personalised layer around smartphone operating systems, contributing to more intuitive user conversations, customised imaging, tailored content, content recommendations, and much more," Prabhu Ram who heads the Industry Intelligence Group (IIG) at CyberMedia Research (CMR), told IANS.

While smartphone apps will remain dominant for now, features such as facial recognition and voice-activated assistants posit to potential alternative interfaces on the horizon.

Motorola appoints TM Narasimhan to lead its India business

Adani Total Gas, Shigan sign MoU for collaboration in decarbonization

Of the 57 IPOs in 2023, 41 received mega response of more than 10 times

New Delhi, Jan 3 (IANS) A total of 57 Indian corporates raised Rs 49,434 crore through main board IPOs in 2023, 17 per cent lower than the Rs 59,302 crore mobilized by 40 IPOs in 2022, according to Prime Database. However, excluding the mega LIC IPO, which came out in 2022, the IPO mobilisation increased by 28 per cent from last year. The overall response from the public, according to Prime Database, was excellent. Of the 57 IPOs, 41 IPOs received a mega response of more than 10 times (of which 16 IPOs got more than 50 times) while nine IPOs were oversubscribed by more than three times. The balance seven IPOs were oversubscribed between 1 to 3 times. In comparison to 2022, the response of retail investors also increased tremendously. The average number of applications from retail increased to 13.21 lakh, in comparison to 5.66 lakh in 2022. The highest number of applications from retail were received by Tata Technologies (52.11 lakh) followed by DOMS Industries (41.30 lakh) and INOX India (37.34 lakh). The amount of shares applied for by retail by value (Rs 1,49,988 crore) was 203 per cent higher than the total IPO mobilisation (in comparison to being 22 per cent lower in 2022) again showing a much higher level of enthusiasm from retail during the period. The total allocation to retail, however, was Rs 13,749 crore which was 28 per cent of the total IPO mobilisation (slightly down from 29 per cent in 2022).

40 companies looking to raise nearly Rs 70,000 cr through IPO let their approval lapse in 2023

New Delhi, Jan 3 (IANS) The IPO pipeline for 2024 continues to remain strong. 27 companies proposing to raise Rs 28,500 crore are presently holding SEBI approval while another 36 companies looking to raise about Rs 40,500 crore are awaiting SEBI approval, as per Prime Database.

According to Pranav Haldea, Managing Director, PRIME Database Group the next couple of months should see several IPOs being launched before a pause on account of the general elections. 2023 saw 87 companies filing their offer document with SEBI for approval (in comparison to 89 in 2022). On the other hand, 2023 also saw 40 companies looking to raise nearly Rs 70,000 crore letting their approval lapse, three companies looking to raise Rs 3,550 crore withdrawing their offer document and SEBI returning the offer document of a further six companies looking to raise Rs 10,800 crore. According to Haldea, IPO response was further buoyed by strong listing performance. Average listing gain (based on closing price on listing date) increased to 29 per cent, in comparison to 11 per cent in 2022.

RT India brings its first multi-stage integrated advertising campaign to India, challenging mainstream media narratives about nation

New Delhi, Jan 3 (IANS) RT India has launched its first major multi-stage integrated India-wide advertising campaign, challenging geopolitical assumptions and the mainstream media's narratives on India. The provocative out-of-home, online and print campaign involves an array of billboard advertising, bespoke bus and taxi wraps, print ads in newspapers, airport takeovers and an array of other formats, nationwide. The first stage of the two-stage campaign initially poses thought-provoking open questions including: "Why does the West still see India as a third-world country?", "Should Europe's problems be India's problems?", and "Why won't Britain return the Koh-I-Noor diamond?". These questions are targeted at the root of broad geopolitical national discussions. "RT India has always sought to tackle head-on the entrenched and pervasive assumptions of Western establishments on India and the Global South at large," said RT deputy editor-in-chief Anna Belkina.
