### Supercross Racing League in Bengaluru

**Pune:** CEAT Indian Supercross Racing League, India's first franchise-based Supercross league, announces a change in venue for the highly anticipated Season One finale. Originally slated for Delhi, the event will now thrill fans in Bengaluru on February 25, 2024, as initially scheduled. Due to unforeseen circumstances necessitating the implementation of some stringent resolutions by authorities, which could potentially create logistical challenges, the organising committee has made a conscious decision to relocate the event to Bengaluru.

### IPC rejects sport ministry's suggestion

**New Delhi:** The world governing body for para sports has rejected sports ministry's suggestion for forming an ad-hoc panel to run the affairs of Paralympic Committee of India (PCI) after the government suspended the national body for not holding elections on time. While suspending the PCI on February 2, the ministry had directed the Sports Authority of India (SAI) to coordinate with the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) to form an ad-hoc committee to undertake the tasks performed by PCI and "conduct free, fair and transparent elections".

### Chess Olympiad initiated golden era

**New Delhi:** All India Chess Federation (AICF) President Sanjay Kapoor expressed immense pride in India finishing the 44th edition of the Chess Olympiad, calling it a dream come true moment for the governing body. The 44th edition of the Chess Olympiad was held in Chennai in the year 2022. The AICF chief reminiscing India's show in the Chess Olympiad, said the performance of the host team initiated a golden era in Indian Chess. More than 2500 players and 7000 had taken part in the global event at that time. "Today, I extend my heartiest congratulations to FIDE on reaching the remarkable milestone of 100 years.

### Bihar crowned rugby champions

**Ahmedabad:** Bihar's sub-junior boys and girls team stamped their authority once again as they emerged winners for the third time in a row at the Sub Junior National Rugby Sevens Championships, held here at IIT-Gandhinagar. The sub-junior Boys continued their winning streak by beating Odisha 35-0 in a one-sided affair. The girls team followed suit by beating Odisha 5-0.

### Another double podium finish for India

**New Delhi:** India registered their fourth double podium finish at the 10M International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) World Cup in Granada, Spain, when Devanshi Dhama struck gold and Lakshita silver in the women's 10m air pistol junior event on competition day two. Devanshi shot 240.0 and Lakshita 238.0 in the eight-woman final as India continued to lead the medal tally with four gold, three silver and two bronze medals in their kitty already. On day one, Umamahesh Maddineni, Parth Mane and Ajay Malik had swept the medals in the junior men's 10m air rifle.
