New Delhi: The release of a double murder convict, who once even escaped from Tihar jail and stands sentenced to life term with a 30-year cap on remission, has left the kin of the victims terrified.

Jitender, the convict, is now on furlough even while serving a sentence of rigorous imprisonment for life for two murders on the same day.

On March 10, 1999, Jitender stormed into a wedding reception in north Delhi and shot dead Anil Bhadana, the then president of Satyawati College Students' Union, because Bhadana was about to depose against him in a pending criminal case. The same night, he went to the house of Sumit Nayyar, an evewitness who had informed police about Bhadana's murder, and pumped three bullets into the chest of Nayyar's

father as he opened the main

door, killing him on the spot. Alleging that the convict hid facts from the court, the panic-stricken family of the victim has approached the Supreme Court, urging it to put him back in jail to serve the remainder of his sentence and cancel his furlough. The plea is likely to be heard today.

The plea argues that Jitender took advantage of a blanket court order granting On March 10, 1999, Jitender considered for early release by the Sentence Review Boshot dead Anil Bhadana, ard(SRB) of Delhi. who was about to depose On the batch of petitions against him in a pending before it, the court had also

granted exemption from surrendering to several convicts by various orders passed in the last year. By challenging SRB's refusal to consider his case, Jitender ended up as one such beneficiary.

It alleges that Jitender hid the fact that he is not eligible to be considered by SRB for premature release because he has been sentenced to life imprisonment with a 30-year cap on remission, which is why SRB has not entertained his case.

The applicant says he is now apprehensive of a genuine threat to life, as Jitender, within a gap of two and half hours of the first murder, had traced the house of the witness to the first murder and committed murder of the father of the said witness in a vecold-blooded manner when he could not find the

witness at the house. In 2016, the families of the victims were in a shock when the Delhi High Court released him. It convicted Jitender but set him free on a period of roughly 16 years undergone behind bars, observing that "Tooth for tooth and eye for eye" cannot be the criteria for handing down punishment to

convicts in a civilised society. After TOI highlighted how scared witnesses questioned the move, the court blamed "typograhical error" for the faux pas, changed its earlier order and directed the immediate arrest of Jitender, who by then had gone missing. It was only when the SC stepped in that the man was awarded a 30-year jail term without remission and sent

behind bars.

## 'Pressure on mohalla clinic docs to reduce tests'

"There is a serious lapse/misconduct on the part of the district nodal officer, cluster in charge, and project director who failed to supervise and monitor the scrutiny of tests properly. The data indicates a massive fraud, manipulation of records by the outsourced labs with an intention to create a


huge loss to the govt exchequer amounting to crores of rupees," an ACB mentioned in the PE.

Following an impact assessment study conducted earlier in seven mohalla clinics by the health and family welfare department of Delhi govt, LG VK Saxena had recommended a CBI investigation into it. A separate inquiry by ACB was also recommended in the case.

According to ACB's PE report, mentioning the name and mobile number of the patient was compulsory for making an entry in the Lab Information Management System, as the reports were also required to be sent to the registered mobile number. Since the system was designed and developed by the outsourced agencies, they had full control and access

over the entire data. "Hence, the possibility of manipulation of data by the outsourced lab vendors could not be ruled out," the report added. ACB had also conducted random televerification of mobile numbers of patients at both private labs, which revealed that a large number of tests were conducted on either invalid mobile numbers or mobile numbers not related to the patients.

A large number of tests was allegedly done without the presence of treating doctors.



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## **Higher payout** to widow of scavenging victim opposed

New Delhi: The govt has opposed before Delhi High Court its liability to pay enhanced compensation of Rs 30 lakh to the widow of a sanitation worker who died during manual scavenging in 2018.

Delhi govt recently told the court that the widow was paid Rs 10 lakh compensation the same month her husband died as per the then mandate. However, a later Supreme Court decision increased the compensation payable to dependents of all such victims of manual scavenging to Rs 30 lakh, would not apply to her.

The court issued notice to the widow on the govt's appeal but asked the authorities to pay her the enhanced compensation in six weeks while it examines the appeal.

Govt argued that since the compensation amount comes from the public exchequer, the issue must be treated as final once payment is done as per the rules applicable at the time.

Observing that manual scavengers have lived in inhuman conditions for a long time, the Supreme Court in Oct 2023 asked the Centre and state govts to eradicate the practice across the country. While passing a slew of directions for the benefit of people involved in manual scavenging, it had asked the govts to pay Rs 30 lakh to the kin of those who die while cleaning sewers.

In Nov 2023, a single judge held that the top court's decision would apply to the present case as well where the woman's husband inhaled poisonous gases while working inside a sewer and died of suffocation on Aug 6, 2018.



New Delhi: India is in a "great spot" and could realise a growth rate of about 7.6% or more in 2024-25, said Sanjay Nayar, the new president of the Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India (Assocham). However, a lot hinges on the monsoon rains and global inflation, which influences the interest rate regime, he said. The National Statistical Office, in its second advance estimate, pegged the country's 2023-24 growth at 7.6%, which Nayar said was "like hitting the ball out of the park" gi-

ven the global turmoil. In an interview to ET. Navar called on the government to maintain its capital expenditure push for some more time to "crowd in" private investment. Rural consumption has started to see an uptick, on top of the already strong urban demand, he said. # GST on Corp Guarantees: SC to Offer Clarity, say Officials

### Our Bureau

Bengaluru: A clarity on the contentious provision of levying GST on corporate guarantees between two related entities will emerge only after the Supreme Court gives its final word on the subject, and until then, holding companies are likely to keep getting demand notices, a section of GST officials told ET.

Several companies caught in the crosshairs of the GST authorities got a sense of relief last week after the Punjab & Haryana High Court stayed operation of a central board of indirect taxes & customs (CBIC) circular clarifying on the validity of the levy. CBIC's October 27, 2003, circular

had clarified that a corporate guarantee, provided by one company to banks or financial institutions to help an associate company secure a loan, even without a consideration, should be considered supply of service between related parties under the Schedule I of the CGST Act, 2017.

Ever since the CBIC put out the clarification, the GST authorities have started demanding GST at 18% on one percent of the value of corporate guarantees. The latest stay, issued in the case of Acme Cleantech Solutions, arises from a legal challenge the company mounted on both the constitutional validity of the guarantee as well as its valuation for levy of the impost.

The recent spate of stay orders from different courts in favour of petitioner companies would

not prevent demand notices to other companies, GST officials in Bengaluru said, declining to be identified. The authorities, while acknowledging the recent stay order stopping the operation of the circular, said the subject would hang fire till it finally gets settled in the Supreme Court. "Until then, the stay order issued by the court in Chandigarh will only have a persuasive value in cases pending before other high courts," the officials added.

Hundreds of petitions challenging the October 23 notification of CBIC are pending before high courts and most have not paid the taxes, they said. "We got very little revenue from this as most of the demand notices remain stayed by courts," the official added.

### **Coal Import** Rises 8% to 268 MT in FY24

New Delhi: India's coal import rose by 7.7 per cent to 268.24 million tonne (MT) in FY24 driven by softness in seaborne prices and likelihood of increase in power demand during summer. The country's coal import was 249.06 MT in FY23, according to data compiled by B2B e-commerce company mjunction services. Coal import in March FY24 also rose to 23.96 MT, over 21.12 MT in the corresponding month of the previous fiscal. Of the total volume recorded in March 2024, non-coking coal import stood at 15.33 MT, against 13.88 MT in March FY23. Coking coal import in March 2024 was 5.34 MT against 3.96 MT a year ago. -PTI
