Croatia's Defense Min sacked after causing a car crash

ZAGREB: Croatia's defense minister was sacked on Saturday after he apparently caused a traffic collision in which one person died and he was also seriously injured. Defense Minister Mario Banozic was overtaking a truck in bad weather when he crashed into a van coming from the opposite direction, authorities said. The van driver died in the crash and Banozic was hospitalised with serious injuries. "I have removed Minister Banozic from duty of the defense minister, considering the extraordinary circumstances," Prime Minister Andrej Plenkovic said shortly after initial findings were published about the crash in eastern Croatia. The accident happened around 6 am on Saturday. Banozic, 44, was driving his personal car and was traveling on his own. "We are expressing our condolences to the family of the person who was killed," government spokesman Marko Milic said earlier on Saturday on X, formerly known as Twitter.

The deputy prosecutor in the eastern town of Vukovar, Biljana Luburic, said Banozic's blood and urine samples were taken for testing. According to the crash report, Banozic was overtaking another vehicle "without checking if it can be done safely and without taking into consideration the weather conditions." He suffered head and brain contusions, as well as multiple body trauma. He remained under observation, but his injuries are not life-threatening. Local Index news portal said Banozic was apparently going hunting when he crashed. Photos from the scene showed Banozic's car turned on its side next to the badly damaged van on a rainy and foggy day.

US President set to meet China's Xi on Nov 15 in San Francisco

This meeting is significant as the leaders have not met since the G20 in 2022

PORTSMOUTH(UK): US president, Joe Biden, is expected to meet China's leader, Xi Jinping, in San Francisco as part of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (Apec) conference on Wednesday November 15.

Their meeting has great significance, as the two leaders have not met since the G20 in 2022, and because of their lack of agreement concerning current global conflicts, particularly the Ukraine war. Biden's relationship with Xi is already strained. At the G20 meeting, Biden spoke with Xi about China's position on Taiwan (the US is worried about China military action towards the self-governing island), the Russian invasion of Ukraine (the US would like China to bring an end to the conflict), and the US-China trade relationship (which has been extremely rocky). These issues are all expected to be on the agenda. While the US-China relationship is unlikely to be the deciding factor in 2024's US presidential election, it could feature.

Around 83% of Americans have a negative view of China, with people concerned about

China's role in the world and the fate of Taiwan, according to Pew Research. But Chinese attitudes to the US might be mellowing. According to a poll conducted in October, fewer Chinese (48%) think of the US as an enemy than in 2022 (74%). What Biden needs: Biden is unlikely to significantly change his current position on China, one that aims to curb China's economic growth and limit its diplomatic influence while maintaining US geopolitical dominance.

But the Atlantic Council think-tank suggests that maintaining open dialogue with

China will gain Biden support from the US public. Only 13% of Americans want a confrontational approach to China, a recent poll suggests.

Biden needs a bump in the polls. Latest surveys on the upcoming presidential election put Biden slightly behind Trump, despite record job creation and 3.7% inflation nearing US Federal Reserve's target level of 2%.

In the Washington Post, political correspondent Olivier Knox speculates that discussions around AI will be on the agenda. The US secretary of state, Antony Blinken, believes that AI

should not be involved in the decision-making processes concerning the use of nuclear weapons.

Earlier in November, China signed a declaration at the AI Safety Summit, hosted by the UK at Bletchley Park, signalling a commitment to an international approach to AI and its use.

There has been a flurry of meetings between Chinese and US officials in the lead up to the Apec summit. Janet Yellen, the US treasury secretary, was due to meet the Chinese vice premier, He Lifeng, ahead of the Biden-Xi meeting.

The Trump factor: With an election in 12 months' time, Biden cannot be seen to be weak towards China. His likely Republican opponent, former president Donald Trump, has continuously adopted a belligerent attitude towards China's economic challenge to the US, introducing a number of tariffs on Chinese imports after 2018.

In January 2020, Trump signed what he called an "historic trade deal" with China that committed China to buying US 200 billion (163 billion) of

US exports before the end of 2021. But China did not keep their end of the bargain, with one report stating that China only bought 58% of the agreed amount, less than it had before the agreement.

There are suggestions that the possibility of Trump returning to the White House is making diplomats around the globe reluctant to commit to long-term partnerships with the US. Trump has promised to "tax China to build up America".

This would resume the trade war that resulted in the Trump administration placing tariffs on Chinese exports to the US.

This meeting could cap tension levels and offer some stability for further negotiations. For Biden, it's a domestic minefield. If he is too "hard" in his positioning, he risks alienating the electorate, while if he is too soft, he will attract criticism from Republicans. If Biden can walk this tightrope successfully, he may be able to use it during next year's election cycle, showing he's the right person to lead the United States. (The Conversation) AGENCIES

Hezbollah says it is introducing new weapons in ongoing battles with Israeli troops

BEIRUT: The leader of Lebanon's militant Hezbollah group said on Saturday his fighters have introduced new weapons, including a missile with a heavy warhead in the ongoing fighting along the Lebanon-Israeli border, adding that they will keep using the tense frontier to pressure Israel.

Sayed Hassan Nasrallah also blasted the United States over the Israel-Hamas war, saying it is the only country that can stop Israel's wide offensive on the Gaza Strip but

Hezbollah on Friday attacked northern Israel with three suicide drones after an Israeli strike in central Syria killed seven Hezbollah fighters.

Nasrallah did not claim responsibility for a suicide drone attack that hit the Israeli Red Sea town of Eilat on Thursday but called it "a

great achievement." Hezbollah and Israeli troops have been exchanging fire along the Lebanon-Israel border since October 8, a day after Hamas' deadly assault in southern Israel that left at least 1,200 Israeli civilians and troops dead and more than 200 taken hostages. "The side that can stop this aggression, is the side that is managing this aggression. It is America," Nasrallah said, referring to the United States, a main supporter of Israel. AGENCIES

Cambodia deports 25 Japanese suspected of online scams

PHNOM PENH: Twenty-five Japanese nationals suspected of involvement in a cyberscam operation based in Cambodia were deported to Japan on Wednesday, said Gen. Khieu Sopheak, a spokesperson for Cambodia's Interior Ministry.

The Japanese government arranged a charter flight to transport the suspects, who were detained in September after Cambodian police received a tip-off from their Japanese counterparts, he told The Associated Press.

The 25 were arrested in the capital, Phnom Penh, according to Gen. Keo Vantham, a spokesperson for the immigration police.

Khieu Sopheak thanked the Japanese government "for their support and good cooperation with the Cambodian government in order to arrest these people".

Cybercrime scams have become a major issue in Asia. In August, the U.N.'s human rights office said that criminal gangs have forced hundreds of thousands of people in Southeast Asia into participating in unlawful online scam operations, including false romantic ploys, bogus investment pitches and illegal gambling schemes. The office of the U.N. High Commissioner for Human Rights in a report cited "credible sources" saying that at least 120,000 people in strife-torn Myanmar and roughly 100,000 in Cambodia "may be affected". The report sheds new light on cybercrime scams that have become a major issue in Asia. AGENCIES
