At 61.5, flash composite PMI rises to 7-month high in February

BIG BOOM. Business activity sees expansion driven by strong demand for both manufacturing and services

With better performance in both manufacturing and services, the HSBC Composite Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) rose to a seven-month high of 61.5 in February, up from 61.2 in January. However, there is not-so-good news on the job front.

"New export orders rose sharply, particularly for goods producers. Input prices rose at the slowest pace in three-and-a-half-years. Producers were able to do both — lower the rate of increase in output prices and improve margins," Pranjal Bhandari, Chief India Economist at HSBC said.

The flash manufacturing PMI touched 60.4 in February, compared to 59.7 of January. Simultaneously, the Flash services PMI climbed to 62 from 60.4.

Normally, PMI data is released during the first week

of the month. However, flash data is now being prepared to ascertain the trends of private business in India. Manufacturing and services, together, have a share of around 70 per cent in Gross Value Added (GVA).

The flash PMI is prepared by S&P Global from responses to questionnaires sent to survey panels of around 400 manufacturers and 400 service providers.

The panels are stratified by detailed sector and company workforce size, based on contributions to GDP. The services sector is defined by S&P Global as consumer (excluding retail), transport, information, communication, finance, insurance, real estate and business services. Index above 50 means expansion and below 50 indicates contraction.

UNCHANGED PAYROLL
Talking about job scenario, a report released along with indices, noted that despite

the ongoing growth of new orders, private sector companies in India refrained from recruiting extra workers during February.

"Payroll numbers were unchanged since January, thereby ending a 20-month sequence of job creation. Anecdotal evidence suggested that workforces were sufficient for current requirements," it said. It may be noted that manufactur-

ing is considered the biggest job multiplier.

Meanwhile, there was some positive development on the price front. The report said that the rate of charge inflation for Indian goods and services receded to the weakest in a year, as companies generally observed a lack of cost pressures.

The report highlighted that new orders came from

both the domestic and global markets, though the later had performed better. "International markets again made a positive contribution to companies' order books, as seen by the fastest expansion in new export work since last September," the report said. Further, the upturn was led by goods producers. External sales were reportedly fuelled by stronger demand from clients based in Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, the Americas and the Middle East, added the report.

However, not everything is well as overall level of business confidence slipped from January's four-month high, but remained indicative of a robust degree of optimism towards growth prospects. Positive sentiment was pinned on hopes that market conditions will remain favourable, thereby boosting demand for goods and services and subsequently supporting economic output.

'Economy estimated to grow at 6.5% in FY25'

Indian economy is estimated to grow at 6.5 per cent during Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-25, India Ratings and Research (Ind-Ra) said on Thursday. The agency also expects the pace of private investment to accelerate if the present government returns to power.

The agency's projection is 50 basis points (bps) lower than Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) projection of 7 per cent, but at par with International Monetary Fund's (IMF) projection of 6.5 per cent. Growth during current fiscal is estimated at 7.3 per cent. The agency said that economic recovery is on track owing to multiple factors including sustained government capex, healthy corporate performance, deleveraged corporate and banking-sector balance sheets, continued softness in global commodity prices and the prospect of a new private capex cycle.

POSITIVE OUTLOOK

The agency said that while growth in the next fiscal is expected to be lower, this is not going to affect private investment cycle which bodes well for the economy. "When we

look at lead indicators, all of them are indicating that at the current juncture, the private corporate sector is once again becoming more bullish about investments..." Sunil Kumar Sinha, Principal Economist at Ind-Ra said in a press conference here.

According to the agency, ₹3.53-lakh crore was raised in 2022-23 to finance a total of 982 large projects — those over ₹1,000 crore. This is significantly higher than the ₹1.98-lakh crore raised to finance 791 such projects in 2021-22. According to Sinha, while it's still "early days" for the private capex cycle, companies are also gaining confidence from their belief that the likelihood of another shock is low.

"With demand picking up, capacity utilisation in the private sector should start rising from the current aggregate level of 75 per cent. Meanwhile, certain segments such as cement and steel have already seen their capacity utilisation levels cross 80-85 per cent. As such, investments has already begun taking place in those sectors," he said.

However, the agency cautioned that consumption demand was still skewed in favour of households with the upper 50 per cent of incomes.

Greece PM Mitsotakis calls for stronger ties, invites investments in tourism and infra

Greece wants to foster strong connections with India, its Prime minister Kyriakos Mitsotakis said here on Thursday.

Calling for a broad based partnership between two countries, Mitsotakis urged India Inc to explore investments in infrastructure, logistics and new sectors like

hospitality and tourism.

"We are two ancient civilisations with great respect for each other. We have great people-to-people connections and we want to foster the connections further," the Greek Prime Minister said at an event organised by FICCI.

Relations between India and Greece are on an upswing after Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited the country last year. Mitsotakis said that

the India-Middle East-Europe corridor will develop further linkages between the two countries and stressed the importance of strengthening supply chains and logistics.

GOING STRONG

Despite the Covid-19 pandemic and geo-political uncertainties, Greek economy is growing at a much faster pace than that of Eurozone. "We

have done so while, at same time, maintaining tight fiscal discipline," he said. He also cited the political stability in Greece as one of its advantages. There is a great untapped opportunity in tourism and hospitality sectors, he said.

"We still don't have non stop flights connecting Greece with Mumbai or Delhi. I'm sure this will change quickly," he said.

Steel PLI 2.0 put on hold for now, five firms start rolling out products under existing scheme

The performance linked incentive (PLI) 2.0 scheme for speciality steel has currently been put on hold and proposals relating to it could be explored only after a review of the performance of the first phase, which is currently ongoing, senior officials of the Union Steel Ministry told businessline.

The review will be carried out of the proposals that take place under PLI 1.0, including the time taken to roll out of products (under it) and the financial outgo, apart from market demand for new products, before any announcement on PLI 2.0 is made. Proposals could come under a new policy head too.

PLI 2.0, which was target-

ing a disbursement of ₹4,300-4,500 crore, would cover segments like coated and plated steel, high strength and wear-resistant offerings, speciality rails, alloys including wires and tubes, electrical steel, among others. The scope of PLI 2.0 was to cover strategic sectors like defence, nuclear space and infrastructure.

"We do envisage that there will be interest in specialised steel making. But since these projects have long gestation period, and are high capex, a call has to be taken considering the change in market conditions in future. Right now, the focus would be on putting in place PLI 1.0 and ensure its roll out," the official said adding, "So PLI 2.0 is on-hold at the moment."

In the case of PLI 1.0, MoUs have not been received in respect of 13 approved ap-



plications, and the official said that despite attempts these applicants have not been on-boarded for the ongoing scheme. Out of the 67 approved applications, 54 MoUs were inked.

Drop-outs happened for various reasons that include changing demand patterns, high capex, environment clearances and land litigation, absence of expertise in

the segment, and also because clearances were granted in parts and not as a whole.

PLI 1.0 REVIEW

Under PLI 1.0, five companies have started rolling out specialised steel while nine more look at launching coated steel products by Q1 (April - June) of next fiscal, the official said. All 14 companies were expected to roll out products by December-end. Some of the listed entities have been first off-the-block in terms of rolling out speciality offerings.

The last review carried out by the Steel Ministry in December shows ₹13,000 crore worth of investments (43 per cent), out of a proposed ₹30,000-odd crore under PLI 1.0, has already been made and another ₹3,000

crore - ₹5,000 crore is expected taking it up to ₹18,000 crore by FY24-end.

Around ₹10,000 crore worth of investments are expected to be made towards new facilities next fiscal, officials said.

An internal note of the Ministry, which was documented in September, said MECON — the project management agency for PLI 1.0 — received 54 signed MOUs from 26 companies with an investment commitment of ₹29,285 crore and downstream capacity addition of 24.7 million tonnes (mt). Incremental production was 8.6 mt and incentive outgo was around ₹2,300 crore.

Disbursals for PLI 1.0 are expected to start next fiscal onwards and a provision of ₹270 crore is made in the interim Budget.

'India best placed to export components for over 60 GW of upcoming global offshore wind capacity'

International wind turbine manufacturers command large production bases in India, which can double as an export hub, particularly to tap the more than 60 gigawatt (GW) of upcoming global offshore wind capacity, S&P Global Commodity Insights said in its latest report.

"We expect average annual wind additions (onshore) of around 4 GW between 2024 and 2030. Based on that, the Indian market is already around 4 times oversupplied," S&P Global Commodity Insights Associate Director of Analysis of Gas, Power and Climate Solutions Indra Mukherjee said.

A lot of the manufacturing in India is owned by regionally diversified western turbine makers, who supply al-

most everywhere outside China and prominently in Europe and the US. This opens opportunities for exports, he added. Prominent western turbine makers such as Vestas as well as specialist equipment makers like TPI Composites have scaled up and modernised their India manufacturing footprint — priming it as an export hub.

"Exports of wind turbine components in 2023 were nearly twice that of 2019

levels in revenue terms. Export opportunities are more attractive for standardised and labour-intensive components like towers and blades and is growing for nacelles too," Mukherjee noted. "However, not all the capacity is suited for exports. A lot of it is owned by domestic turbine makers who don't have international order books," he pointed out.

According to S&P Global Commodity Insights' top 10

trends in clean energy technology in 2024, global installations of wind and solar will reach one terawatt (TW) in the next two years, taking global installations to 3.5 TW and pressing an urgent need for more flexible power systems. But it is offshore wind that is set for an "unprecedented milestone" year.

"More than 60 GW of new offshore capacity are set to be auctioned in at least 17 different markets — an all-time record high," S&P Global Commodity Insights Clean Energy Technology Lead Eduard Sala de Vedruna said.

SOLAR MODULES

India leads solar PV manufacturing expansions outside of mainland China. "India has now significant solar PV module manufacturing to serve the growing domestic market and to export to international markets (mostly US) after success of local in-

centive manufacturing program (PLI) and duties (BCD)," S&P Global Commodity Insights' principal research analyst of gas, power and climate solutions Jessica Jin said.

India was heavily dependent on module imports until the implementation of the basic custom duty (BCD) in April 2022. The production linked incentive (PLI) scheme stimulates PV manufacturing and will be central to reach module self-sufficiency before 2026, she added.

Module capacity in India by the end of 2023 was 10 GW more than anticipated at the beginning of the year. New investors entered module manufacturing apart from winners of the PLI rounds, stimulated by both attractive local manufacturing policies and opportunities to manufacture in India and ship to the international markets.
