The Company has challenged the authority of DoT to issue penalty demand notices before Delhi/Mumbai High Courts for alleged non-compliance with subscriber verification guidelines. The Company has obtained stay from High Courts against various demand notices and the matters are pending adjudication. Circulars are contrary to Section 20A of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885. The update relates WP (C) No.

The details of any change in the status and/ or any development in relation to such proceedings	On January 31, 2024, the Company requested permission from Hon'ble Delhi High Court to withdraw WP (C) No. 3000/2018 with liberty to approach the concerned High Court by filing a petition challenging the Circular and to obtain interim protection. Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has granted the permission and liberty and has extended the interim protection for six weeks to enable the Company to approach Mumbai High Court to challenge the circular and get interim Orders in it's favour. Expected financial implication, if any: Rs. 236.90 Cr
