Sub: Request for reclassification from Promoter/ Promoter Group Category to Public Category

Ref: Regulation 31A of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015

Ref: Shangar Decor Limited, Company Security Id: SHANGAR/ Code: 540259

I, Himani Jhaveri (Daughter of Mr. Shripal Jhaveri) (Divorcee of Mr. Moulin Shah) am being disclosed as a Promoter of M/s. Shangar Decor Limited ("**The Company**") in the shareholding pattern filed by the Company as Himani Shah with the BSE Limited ("**BSE**") in accordance with the SEBI LODR Regulations. As on date, I am holding 25,200 Equity Shares of Shangar Decor Limited fully paid up, representing 0.21 % (which is less than 1 %) of Paid-up Equity Share Capital of the Company.

I hereby inform that my name as Himani Shah was disclosed as the Promoter of the Company as being spouse of Mr. Moulin Samir Shah, who is also one of the Promoters of the Company. I further state that I, Himani Shah and Mr. Moulin Samir Shah, had departed from the married life pursuant to the Decree passed by the Honorable Judge of Family Court, Ahmedabad vide order dated 18th November, 2019. As on date of this application, I do not have any direct or indirect relation with Mr. Moulin Samir Shah or with any of the other promoters of the Company. I herewith attach certified true copy of the Decree passed by the Honorable Judge of Family court No. 5, Ahmedabad under the Case no. 1943 of 2019 for your reference.

As on date, I am not directly or indirectly, associated with the business of the Company and do not exercise any influence over the business and policy decisions made by the Company. Further, I am not involved in the day-to-day activities of the Company nor exercising any control over the affairs of the Company. Accordingly, I wish to reclassify my status from the "Promoter" category to the "Public" category in the Company.

In connection with my request for reclassification, I hereby confirm and certify that –

1. I, along with the persons related to me together:
 - A. hold 25,200 Equity shares of the Company, which is equal to 0.21 % of the paid-up Equity share capital of the Company, and so meet the requirement of 'not holding more than ten percent of total voting rights as per Regulation 31A, sub-regulation 3, clause (b), sub-clause (i);
 - B. do not exercise control over the affairs of the Company, directly or indirectly;
 - C. do not have any special rights with respect to the Company through formal or informal arrangements including through any shareholder agreements;
 - D. am not represented on the board of directors of the Company (including through nominee director);
 - E. am not acting as a Key Managerial Personnel in the Company;

- F. am not a 'Willful Defaulter' as per the Reserve Bank of India Guidelines; and
- G. am not a Fugitive Economic Offender.

2. There is no pending regulatory action against me;
3. I shall continue to comply with the conditions mentioned at sub-clauses (i), (ii) and (iii) of clause (b) of Regulation 31A (3) of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 at all times from the date of re-classification, failing which, I shall automatically be reclassified as 'Promoter' / Person belonging to Promoter Group of the Company;
4. I shall comply with the conditions mentioned at sub-clauses (iv) and (v) of clause (b) of Regulation 31A (3) of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 for a period of not less than three years from the date of reclassification, failing which, I shall automatically be reclassified as 'Promoter' of the Company.

Further, as on date, I, along with the person related to me (as defined under sub-clauses (ii), (iii) and (iv) of clause (pp) of sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 2 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018), do not, together, hold more than 1 % (one percent) of the total voting rights in the Company and thus meet the requirement as per proviso (a) to amended Regulation 31A, sub-regulation 3, clause (a), sub-clause (iii).

Accordingly, I request the Board of Directors of the Company to kindly take this application on record and initiate the process of reclassification under Regulation 31A of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 to re-classify the status from 'Promoter and Promoter Group Category' to 'Public Category'.

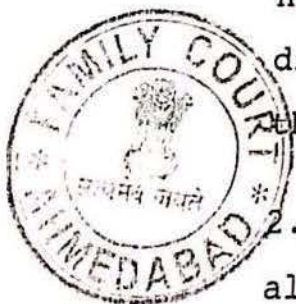

1. The petitioners have filed this petition for obtaining decree of divorce by mutual consent under Section 13(B) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
2. The brief facts giving rise to the present petition are that the marriage between the petitioners was solemnized on 27.02.2009 at Chicago, USA according to Hindu rites and rituals and after the marriage, they started living together as husband and wife. It is the common say of the petitioners that serious disputes and differences cropped up between them during their married life and their relations worsened to such an extent that it became impossible for them to live together as husband and wife. According to petitioners, they have been residing separate from each other since 27.12.2017 and since then they have no marital relations. That their family members and relatives have made efforts for reconciliation, but all went in vain. According to petitioners, they realized that it is not possible for them to live together as husband and wife and it would be in their interest to dissolve their marriage by mutual consent, and therefore, they have filed this petition for obtaining a decree of divorce by mutual consent under Section 13(B) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.



- 2.1 According to petitioners, they have also exchanged their articles, belongings/



ornaments, valuables, etc. from each other and now nothing remains to be exchanged.

2.2 According to the petitioners, they have one daughter named Kiara out of their wedlock and the custody of minor shall remain with the petitioner No.1. It was further agreed that petitioner No.1 shall look after and maintain the minor and shall fulfill his all the obligations towards the daughter in future. Moreover, petitioner No.2 shall have visitation rights to meet the minor daughter on every alternate Saturday and Sunday inclusive of Saturday night. It is also agreed that petitioner No.1 will drop Kiara at the residency of petitioner No.2 on Saturday at 11:00 AM and thereafter, petitioner No.2 would drop minor child Kiara on Sunday evening at or around 9:00 PM at the residency of petitioner No.1. It is also agreed that petitioner No.2 shall also have one more day in the week i.e. during Monday to Friday as per mutually agreed to both the parties.

2.3 As per mutual consent, petitioner No.2 has waived her right to claim maintenance/ permanent alimony from the petitioner No.1 and it is also agreed by and between the petitioners that the petitioner No.2 shall not claim any amount towards permanent alimony / maintenance from the petitioner No.1 in future.



3. The petitioners have filed an application for waiver of statutory period of six months at Exh.9. This Court has made efforts for reconciliation between the parties to this petition under Section 9 of the Family Courts Act, but all efforts went in vain. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case coupled with the settled legal position and ratio laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Amardeep Singh v. Harveen Kaur in Civil Appeal No. 11158 of 2017 (Arising out of SLP (C) No. 20184 of 2017)*, the said application was granted and the statutory period of six months was waived.

4. After taking evidence from both the parties, following order has been passed. The petition came up for hearing and disposal before Hon'ble Judge MRS.S.P.JOSHI, Court No. 5 in the Presence of the petitioners and their advocate, it is hereby ordered and decreed vide Exh -13 as under.

O R D E R

[1] The petition is decreed as per the terms and conditions stated in the petition by the petitioners.

[2] The marriage of the petitioners to this petition is hereby declared to be dissolved with



effect from the date of the decree under Section 13 (B) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

[3] The parties to bear their own costs.
