In accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") vide General Circulars Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021 and latest MCA Circular No. 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023 (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "MCA Circulars") and any other applicable provisions of the Laws and Regulations including any statutory modification(s) or pre-enactment thereof for the time being in force and as amended from time to time, approval of shareholders of TUNI TEXTILE MILLS LIMITED (the "Company") is being sought through Postal Ballot only by way of electronic means ("Remote E-voting") in relation to the various Resolutions as set out in the Postal Ballot Notice ("Notice") dated 4th April 2024.

1. Appointment of Mr. Gaurishankar Ramlal Saraf (DIN: 02411330) as an Independent Director of the Company for a period of 5 years.

To consider and if thought fit to pass with or without modifications the following resolution as a Special Resolution:

- 2. Select "EVEN" of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period and casting your vote during the General Meeting.
- 3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
- 4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
- 5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
- 6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
- 7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.
