'Thangalaan' teaser launch: Vikram was wounded many times, says Ranjith

Chennai, Nov 2: Director Pa Ranjith, at the Thangalaan teaser launch, which was held in Chennai on Wednesday, revealed that Vikram was wounded many times during the shoot for the fight sequences of the film. However, the director didn't cut him any slack and made him work till the required scenes were shot.

"A lot of times, during the fight sequences, I would know that he is wounded. But I am selfish. As a filmmaker, I want to get the shot right. So, I will go and ask, 'Sir, are you okay? Is it paining

sir?' Then I will manage to make him do it again. Sometimes I will just put my head down and ask my assistants to check on him," Ranjith said.

Talking about Vikram, the director said, "He is someone who does justice to the role. Everyone in the world struggles for a living. No one has it easy. However, the dedication to the craft and the intention to make it the best... Vikram sir does that."

Later, when Vikram took the stage he revealed that they had tried using live sound for Thangalaan, which was hard to pull off. "No

one spoke about that. I am good with dubbing (laughs). So, a lot of times I improvise in the dubbing. I did it for Anniyan. However, here Ranjith said it would be great if we did a live recording. So, on top of acting, we have to be conscious of the mic. Another thing is all the scenes in the film are either one shot or two shots. So, the camera keeps moving around the artistes. One has to give it to Ranjith. We all saw his talent in Sarpatta Parambarai. In Thangalaan, he has done 100 times more work."

Thailand to waive visas for Taiwan and India

Thailand, Nov 2: Thailand is all set to waive visa requirements for arrivals from India and Taiwan from next month to May 2024, a government official said on Tuesday, in a bid to draw in more tourists as high season approaches.

Thailand in September scrapped visa requirements for Chinese tourists, the country's top pre-pandemic tourism market with 11 million of the record 39 million arrivals in 2019.

From January to October 29, there were 22 million visitors to Thailand, generating 927.5 billion baht (\$25.67 billion), according to the latest government data.

"Arrivals from India and Taiwan can enter Thailand for 30 days," spokesperson Chai Wacharonke said.

India has been Thailand's fourth largest source market for tourism so far this year with about 1.2 million arrivals after Malaysia,

China and South Korea. Inbound tourism from India showed signs of growth as more airlines and hospitality chains targeted that market.

Thailand is targeting

about 28 million arrivals this year, with the new government hoping the travel sector can offset continued weak exports that have constrained economic growth.
