Minister Munde gets emotional response from farmer

Mumbai, Nov 9 (UNI) : Cheered by the sweet news of crop insurance companies in the state having approved disbursement of crop insurance advance of about Rs 1,700 crore in first phase to nearly 35 lakh farmers in the state on eve of festival of lights, a progressive farmer Govind Balasaheb Deshmukh on Thursday wrote an emotional letter to Agriculture Minister Dhananjay Munde thanking him for his efforts to make them celebrate this Diwali on a happy note.

In the note, he said, "Sir, we have received crop insurance money, now we can celebrate Diwali. Munde did not even accept bouquets and garlands in public meetings and ceremonies until all the technical procedures in crop insurance were completed."

Last month, on October 26, an installment of Rs 2,000 of Namo Kisan Samman Yojana was directly credited to farmers' accounts.

Therefore, farmers have got a little support during the festive period of Diwali.

"Munde had said that if farmers do not get the money of crop insurance, he would not celebrate Diwali either. That's when we thought that someone from our family is occupying the post of Agriculture Minister," he added.

Deshmukh has sent Diwali gifts to Munde and requested him to celebrate Diwali now.

Manipur seeks Rs 476 crores from Centre for displaced persons

Imphal, Nov 9 (UNI) : Manipur has sought Rs 476 crores from the Centre to help persons displaced during the recent violence in the state, Chief Minister N. Biren said on Thursday.

N. Biren was speaking at a programme where he launched a permanent housing scheme for the displaced persons whose houses had been burnt down and damaged during the disturbances.

The Chief Minister said his government has spent an amount of Rs. 399.82 crores for providing different types of relief assistance to persons and families who were affected by the violence which broke out from May 3.

The state has urged

the Centre to sanction Rs 476 crores to help the displaced persons in the next phase he said.

Biren said out of the amount spent so far, Rs. 11 crore had been for setting up Manipur IT Centre for Exam, Rs. 4.5 crore for providing Television sets for various relief camps, Rs. 150 crore in construction of prefabricated houses, Rs. 101 crore in relief camps management for six months and Rs. 89.22 crore for providing nutrition and winter preparedness, including breakfast for children in relief camps.

He said the state government has already provided financial assistance of Rs. 1000 each to people staying at relief camps for the 2nd round. Labour card

holders staying in relief camps had also been provided with Rs. 5000 each as assistance for education of their children, he added. He informed that the Government has taken up the process for providing beds for the displaced people, as the winter season has arrived.

The break up of the Rs 476 crore central assistance sought by the state includes Rs. 6 crores for 2nd round of monetary assistance of Rs. 1000 each to people staying at relief camps, Rs. 360 crores for Permanent Housing Scheme, Rs. 108 crores as second installment for relief camps management and another Rs. 2.5 crore for buying cycles for girls staying at relief camps.

An amount of Rs. 10 lakhs, Rs. 7 lakhs and Rs. 5 lakhs, for construction of damaged or burnt down

constitutional measures. He also appealed to the public to join hands and cooperate in the Government's effort to restore peace in the State.

N. Biren informed the displaced people whose houses had been burnt down and damaged to visit their concerned Deputy Commissioner's (DC) Office and take the financial assistance for construction of their houses under the scheme, adding that DC offices had a verified list of beneficiaries. He also gave advice that family who does not have manpower for construction works can take assistance from District Rural Development Agency (DRDA) by requesting through their concerned DCs

Prohibitory orders in Beed till Nov 23

Beed, Nov 9 (UNI) In view of various kinds of agitations being undertaken by the Maratha community in the district, Additional District Magistrate has issued prohibitory orders under Maharashtra Police Act to maintain law and order in the district up to November 23.

The orders will come into force from 0001 hours at midnight till 2400 hrs on

Nov 23, an official press statement said here on Thursday.

Consequently, any kind of agitations like marches, demonstrations, protests, 'dharna' involving five or more persons has been prohibited without prior permission.

An injunction has been issued under section 37(1)(3) in order to maintain law and order in the district.

Under this, the

possession of weapons, sticks, swords, guns, any inflammable substance or explosives, stones or other missiles, objects causing injury to the body is prohibited. During the period, people should not carry pictures, signs, placards or any other things which may disturb decency, order or endanger the security of the State or may cause disorder, the statement added.
