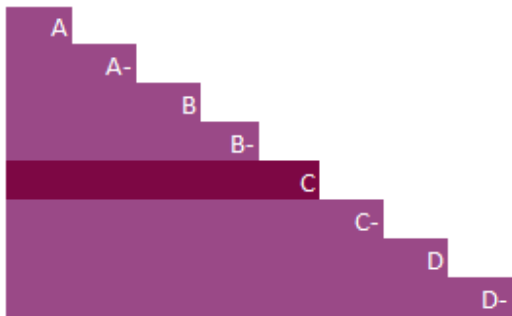

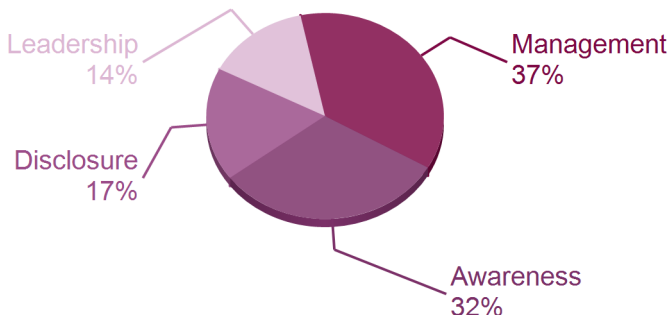

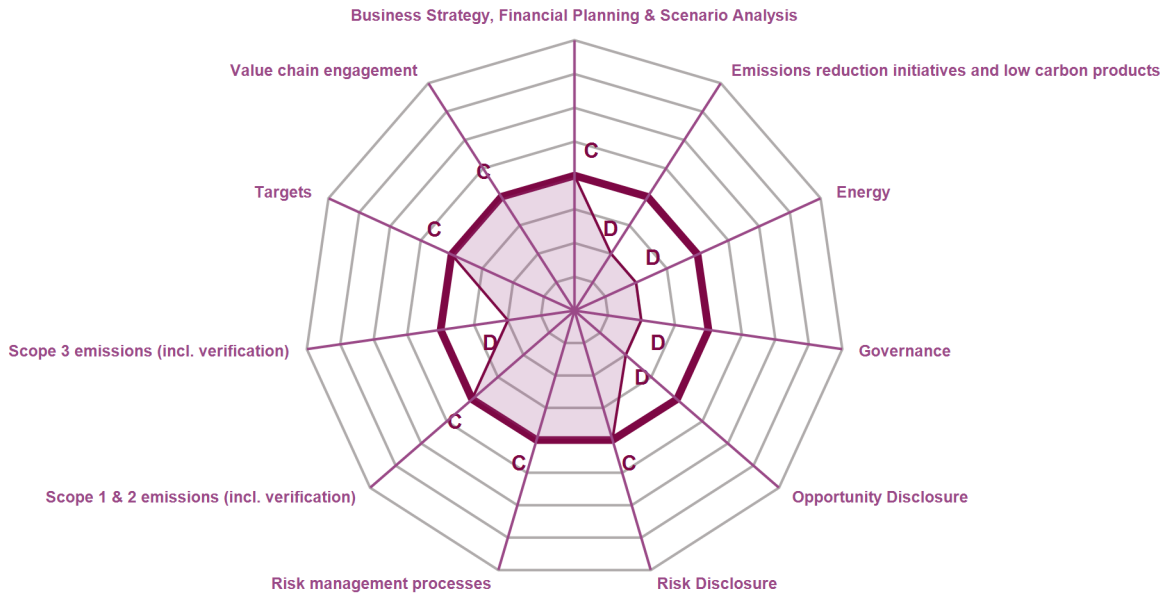

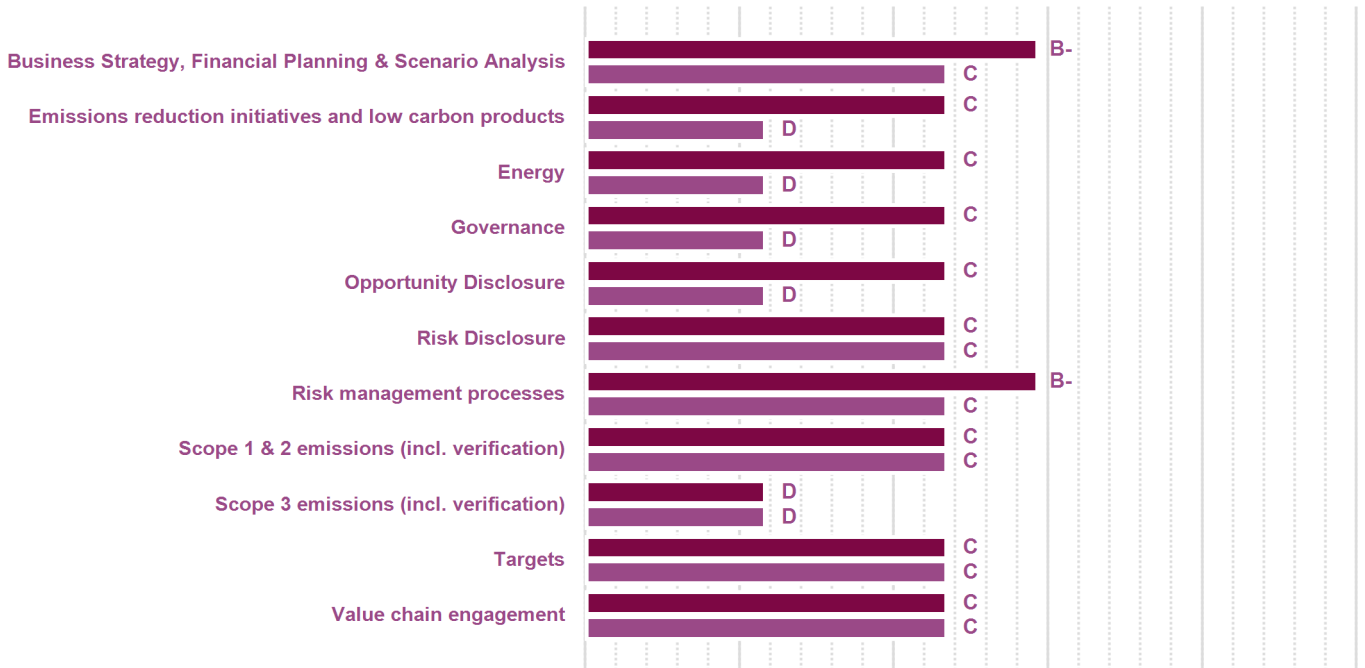
## CATEGORY SCORES
