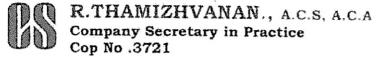

I, R. Thamizhvanan, Practising Company Secretary, (COP No 3721) having its office at S-7. Krishna Arcade, II floor, 10 Rajabathar Street, T. Nagar, Chennai, TN-600017, have been appointed for the purpose of scrutinizing postal ballot process in a fair and transparent manner by the Board of Directors of LTIDPL IndvIT Services Limited, Investment Manager on behalf of the Trust ("IM"), for voting taken on the resolution(s) contained in postal ballot Notice("Notice") dated May 7, 2019, of IndInfravit Trust ("Trust").

Management's Responsibility

The Management of the IM is responsible to ensure compliance with the requirements of the relevant provisions of SEBI InvIT Regulations, and any other Law relating to Postal Ballot Voting for resolutions stated in the Notice.

Scrutinizer's Responsibility

My responsibility as scrutinizer is restricted to making a scrutinizer report of the votes cast by the unit holders in respect of resolution contained in the Notice. My report is based on verification of data provided by Registrar and Transfer agent, and Postal Ballots received through post till the time fixed for closing of the voting process, i.e., on 10th June, 2019 at 18:00 hours IST.

- The locked ballot boxes were subsequently opened in my presence and postal ballot forms were diligently scrutinized. The postal ballot forms were reconciled
