- l, Shashi Shekhar, Company Secretary in whole-time practice was appointed as Scrutinizer to scrutinize the remote e-voting process and also voting by means of Poll at the AGM and for ascertaining the requisite majority on remote e-voting and also on poll carried out for the resolutions proposed to be passed under the provisions of Section 108 and 109 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of Companies (Management and Administration) Amendment Rules, 2015, Rule 21 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 on the resolutions mentioned in notice of AGM dated August 24, 2018 for 25th AGM of the members of the Company held on Tuesday, 25th day of September, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. at The Executive Club, 439, Village Sahoorpur, Fatehpur Beri, New Delhi-110074.
 - 1. Pursuant to Section 108 of the Act and 3(1) of Rule 20 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules. 2014, the Notice convening the Meeting including Statement under section 102 of the Act has been dispatched by post on 31st August, 2018 and by e-mail on 01st September, 2018; and subsequently, the notice convening the meeting was also placed on the website of the Company. The members of the Company were given an option to vote electronically on e-voting platform, provided by the Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL).
- 2. The Public Advertisement with respect to dispatch of notice and conducting of voting through electronic means was published in an English newspaper having wide circulation and a vernacular newspaper on the 02nd September, 2018.

NEW DELHI

- 3. The remote e-voting period remained open from Saturday, 22nd September, 2018 (9:00 A.M.) and end on Monday, 24th September, 2018 (5:00 P.M.) on the designated website www.everaginda.com of Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL).
- The Company has appointed Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) as the service provider for providing the facility of remote e-voting to the members of the Company. The service provider has provided a system for recording the votes of the shareholders electronically on all the items of the businesses sought to be transacted at the 25th AGM of the Company.
- The Members of the Company as on the "cut off date" i.e. 18th September, 2018 were entitled to avail the facility of remote e-voting or voting at the AGM on the proposed resolutions (Item nos. 1 to 6) as set out in the notice dated August 24th, 2018.
- 6. In line with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and in terms of the clarification issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs, voting by show of hands was not permitted at the General Meeting where remote e-voting has been offered to the members. Therefore, the Chairman ordered for poll at AGM as per Rule 20 of Companies (Management and Administration) Amendment Rules, 2015 & Rule 21 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014.
- The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliances with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and rules made thereunder and SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 of 25th AGM of the Company. My responsibilities as scrutinizer are restricted to make a Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast "For" or "Against" the resolutions stated in the notice of AGM.
- 8. After completion of Poll at the AGM votes casted by the members were reconciled with the records maintained by the Registrar and Transfer Agents of the Company and the Authorizations/Proxies lodged with the Company. A detailed register was maintained containing the particulars of the Members who participated in Poll at AGM.
