NOTICE OF POSTAL BALLOT PURSUANT TO SECTION 110 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013.

Dear Member(s),

[Pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended and applicable Circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India, from time to time.]

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Section 110 read with Section 108 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the “**Act**”) (including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force), read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (“**Rules**”), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“**SEBI Listing Regulations**”), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India (“**SS-2**”), each as amended, and in accordance with the requirements prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“**MCA**”) for holding general meetings/conducting postal ballot process through e-voting vide General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, Circular No. 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021 and Circular No. 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022, (collectively the “**MCA Circulars**”), to transact the special business as set out hereunder by passing Special Resolution, by way of postal ballot.

Pursuant to Section 102 and Section 110 and other applicable provisions of the Act, the statement pertaining to the said Resolution setting out the material facts and the reasons/rationale thereof is annexed to this Postal Ballot Notice for your consideration and forms part of this Postal Ballot Notice (“**Notice**”).

Pursuant to Rule 22(5) of the Rules, the Company has appointed Mr. Kamlesh Rajoria, Practicing Company Secretary of M/s. Kamlesh Rajoria & Associates, Practicing Company Secretary (Membership No FCS - 12707 /COP 18010), as the scrutinizer (the “**Scrutinizer**”) for conducting the Postal Ballot (conducted through e-voting), in a fair and transparent manner.

In terms of the requirements specified in the MCA Circulars, Remi Edelstahl Tubulars Limited (“**Company**”) is sending this Notice in electronic form only to those Members whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company/RTA/Depository Participants. Accordingly, physical copy of the Notice along with Postal Ballot Form and pre-paid business reply envelope are not being sent to the Members for this Postal Ballot. The communication of the assent or dissent of the Members would only take place through the remote e-voting system.

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 and Section 110 of the Act read with the Rules, the MCA

Circulars and SS-2, the Company is providing remote e-voting facility to its Members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically instead of submitting the Postal Ballot Form physically. The Company has engaged the services of National Securities Depository Limited (“**NSDL**”) for the purpose of providing remote e-voting facility to its Members. The instructions for remote e-voting are appended to this Notice. The Notice is also available on the website of the Company at www.remigroup.com.

The e-voting commences on Friday, February 2, 2024, at 9.00 a.m. IST and ends on Saturday, March 2, 2024 at 5.00 p.m. IST. The e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. Once the vote is cast by the shareholder, the shareholder shall not be allowed to change it subsequently.

Members desiring to exercise their vote through the remote e-voting process are requested to carefully read the instructions indicated in this Notice and record their assent (FOR) or dissent (AGAINST) by following the procedure as stated in the Notes forming part of the Notice for casting of votes by remote e-voting not later than 5.00 P.M. (IST) on Saturday, March 2, 2024 at 5.00 p.m. IST.

Special Business – Special Resolution:

To approve the extension of terms of redemption of Preference shares

*To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as a **Special Resolution**:*

“RESOLVED that pursuant to Sections 48, 55 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 , corresponding rules thereof and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 if any, subject to consent of the Preference Shareholders, holding 5,00,000 – 8% Non-Cumulative, Non-convertible Preference Shares (NCPS) of Rs.100/- each, aggregating to Rs.5,00,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crores Only) extension of the due date of redemption of the said preference shares is accorded as under ;.

- a) The period of redemption of Preference shares shall be extended for a period not exceeding 5 years from the due date of redemption of Preference shares.
- b) Notwithstanding anything contained above, the Board of Directors shall be at liberty, to vary any of the terms and conditions in respect of the Preference shares as they may deem fit in the best interests of the Company, taking into consideration the circumstances prevailing on the respective date of redemption thereof as aforesaid.
- c) Save as mentioned hereinabove, all other terms and conditions of the said Preference shares shall remain unchanged.”

Instructions for E-voting:

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of “Two Steps” which are mentioned below:

Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system

A) Login method for e-Voting for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode

In terms of SEBI circular dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

Login method for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode is given below:

1. Users who have opted for CDSL Easi / Easiest facility, can login through their existing user id and password. Option will be made available to reach e-Voting page without any further authentication. 2. After successful login the Easi / Easiest user will be able to see the e-Voting option for eligible companies where the evoting is in progress as per the information provided by company. How to Log-in to NSDL e-Voting website?

2. Once the home page of e-Voting system is launched, click on the icon "Login" which is available under 'Shareholder/Member' section.

2. Select “EVEN” of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period.
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on “Submit” and also “Confirm” when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message “Vote cast successfully” will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

1. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) are required to send scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of the relevant Board Resolution/ Authority letter etc. with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(ies) who are authorized to vote, to the Scrutinizer by e-mail to retlscrutinizer@gmail.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.com. 2. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential. Login to the e-voting website will be disabled upon five unsuccessful attempts to key in the correct password. 3. Resolutions passed by the shareholders through postal ballot are deemed to have been passed as if they have been passed at a General Meeting of the shareholders.
4. The voting rights for Equity Shares are one vote per Equity Share, registered in the name of the members. Voting rights shall be reckoned on the paid-up value of Equity Shares registered in the name of the shareholders as on Friday, January 26, 2024. A person who is not a shareholder on the relevant date should treat this notice for information purpose only.

In compliance with Sections 108 and 110 of the Act and the rules made there under, the MCA Circulars and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Company has provided the facility to the shareholders to exercise their votes electronically and vote on the resolutions through the e-voting service facility arranged by NSDL. The e-voting will commence at Friday, February 2, 2024, at 9.00 a.m. IST and ends on Saturday, March 2, 2024 at 5.00 p.m. IST. The instructions for e-voting are provided as part of this Postal Ballot Notice.
8. Shareholders desiring to exercise their vote through the e-voting process are requested to read the instructions in the Notes under the section "General information and instruction relating to e-voting" in this Postal Ballot Notice. Shareholders are requested to cast their vote through the e-voting process not later than 5.00 P.M. (IST) Saturday, March 2, 2024 to be eligible for being considered, failing which it will be strictly considered that no vote has been received from the shareholder.
9. The Scrutinizer shall after the conclusion of voting through postal Ballot (done through evoting) unblock the votes cast through e-voting in a fair and transparent manner, not later than two days of conclusion of the e-voting, a scrutinizer's report of the total votes cast in favour and against, if any, and submit it to the Chairman of the Company or any person authorised by him. The results of the Postal Ballot will be announced on or before Monday, March 4, 2024 and communicated to BSE Limited (the "BSE") (the "Stock Exchange") where the equity shares of the Company are listed. EXPLANATORY STATEMENT UNDER SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013
- ANNEXURE TO THE NOTICE

The Company had issued and allotted 5,00,000 - 8% Non-Cumulative, Non-Convertible Preference Shares (NCPS) of Rs.100/- each, aggregating to Rs.5,00,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crores Only) on 6th March, 2018, to be redeemed at the end of the 6th year, with an option to redeem any time after end of 4th year;. The said shares were allotted on 6th March, 2018 and according to its term to be redeemed at the end of the 6th year i.e. 5th March, 2024.

The due date for the redemption falls on 5th March, 2024. In spite of the best efforts of the Company and in view of the disruption in the business of the Company due to Covid -19 and due to negative growth in the capital goods industry for the last few years it would be difficult for the Company to redeem the said preference shares on the due dates of their redemption. It is also necessary for the company to conserve its financial resources in order to improve the working capital base. Hence, the company is not in a position to redeem the shares on the due dates. The inability to infuse massive fresh funds and the non-feasibility of making fresh issue of shares for the purpose of redemption of the Preference shares, has inevitably led the Board of Directors to approach the Preference Shareholders for their consent to extension of redemption of shares.

The Board believes that there is no alternative to the above proposal and it would serve the long term interests of the Company and the Shareholders. The Board therefore recommends the resolution for approval of the Shareholders. Section 48 of the Companies Act, 2013 states that the rights attached to the shares of any class may be varied with the consent in writing of the holders of not less than three-fourths of the issued shares of that class or by means of a Special Resolution passed at a separate meeting of the holders of the issued shares of that class and if such variation by one class of Shareholders affects the rights of any other class of Shareholders, the consent of three-fourths of such other class of Shareholders shall also be obtained. Hence, the resolution is subject to approval of the Equity Shareholders in the ensuing General Meeting (Postal Ballot).

None of the Directors or Key Managerial Personnel of the Company or their respective relatives of the Company are concerned or interested in the said resolution.

The Board recommends passing of resolutions as set out in this notice.
