Non-urea fertilisers now under pricing control

HARISH DAMODARAN New Delhi, January 29

THE NARENDRA MODI government has brought di-ammonium phosphate (DAP), muriate of potash (MOP) and all other such fertilisers that receive nutrient-based subsidy (NBS) support, under "reasonable pricing" controls.

NBS fertilisers — unlike urea, whose maximum retail price (MRP) is fixed by the government — are technically decontrolled. Under the NBS scheme, introduced in April 2010, their maximum retail prices (MRPs) are supposed to be market-determined and set by the individual companies selling them. The government merely pays a fixed per-tonne subsidy on each of these fertilisers, linked to their nutrient content or specific percentage of nitrogen, phosphorous, potassium and sulphur.

The department of fertilisers (DoF) has now, in an office memorandum dated January 17, issued detailed guidelines for the evaluation of "reasonableness" of MRPs for all non-urea fertilisers covered under NBS.

The guidelines, to be effective retrospectively from April 1, 2023, have prescribed maximum profit margins that will be

Companies earning "unreasonable profit", i.e. over and above the stipulated percentages, in a particular financial year will have to refund the same to the DoF by October 10 of the following fiscal.

If they don't return the money within the said time limit, "an interest @12% per annum on pro-rata basis would be charged on the refund amount from the next day of

end of financial year (i.e. in case of FY 2023-24, the interest would be charged from April 1, 2024)," the memorandum has said. The unreasonable profits would also get adjusted against subsequent fertiliser subsidy payments by the government. Simply put, the new guidelines impose indirect MRP controls on non-urea fertilisers by capping the profits that companies can earn from their sales. These will be based on their "total cost of sales", which would cover cost of production/import, administrative overheads, selling and distribution overheads, and net interest and financing charges. Deduction for dealer's margin

will be allowed to the extent of 2% of the MRP for DAP and MOP, and 4% for all other NBS fertilisers.

The guidelines have mandated fertiliser companies to "self-assess" unreasonable profits, based on the cost auditor's report along with audited cost data approved by their board of directors. This report and data has to be furnished to the DoF by October 10 of the following fiscal year. The DoF will then scrutinise the "reasonability of MRPs", as submitted by the companies, "by 28th February for each completed previous financial year (i.e. for FY 2023-24 by 28 February 2025)". Following that, it will finalise a report on unreasonable profits earned, if any, to be recovered from the firms.

An industry source said the new guidelines basically extend the regime of detailed cost monitoring and price control currently applicable on urea to other fertilisers. The MRP of urea has remained at ₹5,360 per tonne since November 1, 2012. The only change that has taken place is companies being permitted to charge 5% extra (₹268) for neem-coating of urea, made mandatory from May 25, 2015.



'Shantanu Thakur is a Union Minister, who attends Cabinet meetings and therefore, has access to more information. He has made a claim on CAA implementation based on his information. As far as I know, CAA will be implemented by February 29. It may not be implemented in the first half of the next month, but I can clearly say that it will be implemented by February end,"

BJP workers clash with police during Barrackpore protest

EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE KOLKATA, JANUARY 29

A MARCH by BJP workers in Barrackpore of North 24 Parganas district over alleged deterioration of law and order situation in the area turned violent on Monday when the protesters pelted police with stones and broke through barricades.

The police resorted to lathicharge, used water cannons, and fired tear gas shells to disperse the protesting workers led by state party president Sukanta Majumdar.

At least 10 protesters were detained, the police said. A senior police officer said, "Police exercised restraint and only resorted to necessary action when the situation became potentially volatile. However, complaints will be thoroughly investigated and appropriate measures will

The BJP, on the other hand, alleged that several party workers, including women, were injured in the police action. "Today, we came here to protest against the deterioration of the law and order situation. But the police launched an attack on us. Our women workers

have suffered injuries and one of them broke her leg. We strongly condemn such action by the police. We will take up the matter with the National Commission for Women," said Majumdar.

Nearly 25 party workers were injured in the baton-charge and a few were even admitted to a hospital, he claimed.

Later in the day, Majumdar staged a dharna outside the Titagarh police station, demanding that the detained workers be released immediately.

Leader of Opposition in state Assembly Suvendu Adhikari also condemned the incident. "The police launched an assault on our workers without any provocation. They arrested our workers. We demand their unconditional release," said Adhikari during a press conference.

Reacting to the incident, TMC state general secretary Kuna Ghosh said, "The BJP resorted to hooliganism in the name of organising a protest. They broke barricades, and as a result, the police resorted to lathi-charge This was not a peaceful protest. They planned to create a ruckus

Set medical board, examine condition: HC to govt on rape survivor's plea

Kolkata: The Calcutta HC Monday directed the West Bengal government to form a medical board to examine the condition of a 27-year-old rape survivor who wants to terminate her pregnancy. The petitioner's lawyer submitted that she is suffering from grave mental trauma and the court may permit the termination of the pregnancy, stated to be between 20 and 24 weeks.

Sabyasachi Bhattacharyya directed the state government to form a medical board to examine the petitioner's condition and file a report on February 2. Meanwhile, the state counsel submitted that as per the petition, the unfortunate incident took place in July 2023, and as such, the pregnancy may be more advanced than pleaded.

Justice Bhattacharyya directed that the medical board will comprise at least two well-established medical practitioners, one of them must be from the field of gynaecology and another from paediatrics. The petitioner will be examined at the state-run MR Bangur Hospital. The matter is listed for February 2.

"MY BROTHERS and I told her not to stay so late at the jagran... I kept calling her around midnight, but her voice kept breaking so I thought it must be due to the crowd," recalled Vikas (24), the eldest son of 45-yearold Tina who who was killed after a makeshift stage at a jagran collapsed in Southeast Delhi's Kalkaji Mandir on the intervening night of Saturday and Sunday.

Tina was a resident of Tughlakabad Extension. She is survived by four family members — husband Ved Prakash, who is a vegetable seller, Vikas, Barun, an e-rickshaw driver.

Vikas also said, "This is negligence on the part of the temple authorities... How could they hold such a big event without safety measures in place? Who is answerable for my mother's death? She was simply a devotee who wanted to be part of the jagran, like she used to every week."

ईडी, सीबीआइ को लोगों के घर भेजने की धमकी दे रही: ममता

कूच बिहार/सिलीगुड़ी, 29 जनवरी (भाषा)।

पश्चिम बंगाल की मुख्यमंत्री ममता बनर्जी ने सोमवार को भारतीय जनता पार्टी (भाजपा) पर आरोप लगाया कि वह लोगों को धमकी दे रही है कि अगर उन्होंने आगामी लोकसभा चुनाव में उसे वोट नहीं दिया तो उनके घर केंद्रीय जांच एजंसियों को भेज दिया जाएगा।

तृणमूल कांग्रेस प्रमुख ने कूच बिहार में स्थानीय लोगों, विशेषकर राजबोंग्शियों को यह सुनिश्चित करने की सलाह दी कि उनके नाम मतदाता सची में हों ताकि वे संशोधित नागरिकता अधिनियम (सीएए) से खुद को बचा सकें। बनर्जी ने यहां एक सार्वजनिक वितरण कार्यक्रम में कहा कि भाजपा. चुनाव के लिए केंद्रीय एजंसियों का इस्तेमाल कर रही है... वह लोगों को फोन करके धमकी दे रही है कि अगर उन्होंने उसे वोट नहीं दिया तो प्रवर्तन निदेशालय (ईडी) और केंद्रीय अन्वेषण ब्यूरो (सीबीआइ) के अधिकारियों को उनके घर भेज दिया जाएगा।

कलकत्ता हाई कोर्ट की दो पीठों में टकराव के बाद शीर्ष न्यायालय ने लिया संज्ञान

जनसत्ता ब्यूरो नई दिल्ली, 29 जनवरी।

एमबीबीएस में प्रवेश के लिए आरक्षित श्रेणी की सीट के लिए इच्छ्क अभ्यर्थियों को जाति प्रमाणपत्र जारी करने में अनियमितताओं के आरोपों की केंद्रीय जांच ब्यूरो से जांच कराने के मुद्दे से संबंधित याचिकाओं पर सुनवाई अब सुप्रीम कोर्ट करेगा। सोमवार को सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने याचिकाएं अपने हाथ में ले ली। कलकत्ता हाई कोर्ट की दो पीठों में टकराव के बाद सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने यह फैसला लिया है।
