'Study in India' programme to encourage flow of inbound international students in India

New Delhi: To facilitate Internationalization of Higher Education in India, a Program viz. 'Study in India' is under implementation with the objectives to make India a preferred education destination/hub for foreign students; improve the soft power of India with focus on the neighbouring countries and use it as a tool in diplomacy; to rapidly increase the inflow of inbound International Students in India through systematic branding, marketing, social media and digital marketing campaigns; to increase India's market share of global education in the exports; improvement in overall quality of higher education; to reduce the export-import imbalance in the number of international students; growth in India's global market share of International students; and increase in global ranking of India etc.

The programme focuses on attracting International students from select 30 plus countries across South-East Asia, Middle East and Africa. The programme envisages participation of select reputed Indian institutes/universities by way of offering seats for the International students at affordable rates, along with fee waivers for meritorious foreign students ranging from 100% to 25%. A centralised admission web-portal (https://studyingindia.gov.in) acts as a single window for the admission of foreign students.

Moreover, the programme also envisages setting up of call centres for support; algorithm for allocation of seats to the meritorious candidates; selection of top 100 partner institutions on

the basis of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) grading and Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) ranking; branding activities in the target countries; and close coordination with Indian missions abroad and foreign missions in India.

Temperature torture: Don't expect any mercy from sun

VADODARA: The city reeled under scorching heat as the mercury crossed 42 degree Celsius mark on Friday.

According to India Meteorological Department (IMD) website, the maximum temperature that the city registered was 42.2 degree Celsius, a departure of two degrees normal.

Although it was not for the first time this season that the city witnessed mercury level crossing 42 degree Celsius, the minimum temperature

that it registered on yesterday was the decade's highest. The city registered 27 degree Celsius as minimum temperature, which was highest that it has witnessed during the decade.

Between 2009 and 2018, the minimum temperature that the city has registered on this day of the year has remained in the range of 20 to 23.4 degree Celsius. IMD website stated that the city has registered 41.4 degree Celsius as maximum temperature and 27.5 degree Celsius as minimum temperature.

It was on April 14 that the city had registered this season's highest maximum temperature at 42.4 degree Celsius while season's highest minimum temperature was registered on Thursday at 27.6 degree Celsius.

EMRI 108 reported nine heat-related emergencies in

Vadodara and total of 462 in Gujarat till 5pm on Friday. On Thursday, it had registered 21 such cases in Vadodara while a total of 758 such cases were registered across the state, including 194 in Ahmedabad, 51 in Surat and 34 in Rajkot.

The heat-related emergencies related to abdominal pain, BP problem and hypertension, chest pain, ENT bleeding, fainting, dehydration, people falling unconscious and vomiting. A majority of cases in the last two days were of people falling.

VADODARA: MS University bagged funding to the tune of Rs 105 crore for research projects while researchers at the varsity have published 34 patents in three years.

This is what the university has stated while submitting details of sponsored projects and research activities carried out at the campus for the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF).

Recently, when NIRF declared all India Rankings for 2019, it put MSU in the rank band of 100 to 150 in university category and in the rank band of 150 to 200 in overall category. Last year, the varsity's name had not appeared among the top 200 universities in the country.

The NIRF report states that between 2015 and 2017, the university's researchers published a total of 34 patents of which 19 were granted.

Western Railway to develop Udhna as a 'green railway station'

SURAT: The Western Railway (WR) in collaboration with a based textile businessman is developing 'green model railway station' at Udhna, touted to be Gujarat's first.

Official sources said that the more than 1,000 trees will be planted around the premises of the station and close to 300 tree pots installed.

The other green greening efforts, the parapet walls of the station's entry gate is being covered up entirely with plants. Graffiti on environment themes are being put up on the walls of the VIP waiting lounges as well as the ladies waiting lounges to spread environment awareness.

Of these trees, around 41 have been planted in the

memory of the CRPF personnel who lost their lives in a terrorist attack at Pulwama on February 14. Each of the tree planted will remember the valour of the soldiers who sacrificed themselves to protect the country, said sources.

Confirming railway's efforts, area manager CR Garuda told TOI, "The idea of developing a green railway station at Udhna is a first of its kind in the state. Passengers and visitors to the station will be greeted by trees, pots and an environment-friendly atmosphere."

He further said that 41 trees planted here in the memory of the Pulwama martyrs will serve as a constant reminder of the sacrifice made by soldiers for the nation.

Businessman Viral Desai told TOI: "We have planted bottle palms, which will act as the oxygen bombers. The oxygen generating tree species will help keep pollution under control at the railway station. We are using drip irrigation method to nurture the station's greenery and hope our efforts spread awareness among the visitors to keep the environment healthy," he added.
