Keep vigil, take pre-emptive measures to protect society from inimical elements: ADGP Vijay Kumar

Srinagar : A senior police officer reviewed law and order situation in Jammu and Kashmir in the backdrop of the recent protests in some educational institutions. In order to review the prevailing situation, ADGP Law and Order, J&K, Vijay Kumar chaired a meeting of the police, CAPF and intelligence wings in PCR Kashmir today.

The spokesman said Kumar appreciated law enforcing agencies for their 'timely action' and also praised the society for showing maturity. He asked the police officers to take full control of the situation and not allow nefarious designs to exploit the situation.

DC, MD review progress under Jal Jeevan Mission in Udhampur District

Udhampur, : Executive Engineer Jal Shakti, Ashok Kumar Sharma, provided an overview of the progress of work under the Jal Jeevan Mission scheme in the district. Snowfall in Sonamarg; night temperature rises at several places

Srinagar : Jammu and Kashmir's Sonamarg tourist resort recorded light snowfall for the second day on Friday while the Meteorological Department forecast significant improvement in weather across the union Territory, officials said.

The three-week dry spell in Kashmir ended on Thursday with snowfall in the higher reaches of the Valley and rains in the plains. While snowfall was recorded in Gulmarg in north Kashmir, Sonamarg in central Kashmir, and other areas in the middle and higher reaches on Thursday, light snowfall continued in Sonamarg, in Ganderbal district, on Friday morning as well, the officials said.

The Met Office said several places experienced partly to generally cloudy weather with light snow over Sonamarg and adjoining areas. However, it said, there would be a significant improvement in the weather towards the afternoon over most places and the weather is likely to remain dry ahead. From December 2 to 7, the weather would remain partly cloudy, while from December 8 to 10, it would be partly to generally cloudy, the officials said.

Encounter breaks out between security forces, terrorists in Pulwama

Srinagar : An encounter broke out between a joint team of the Jammu and Kashmir Police and security forces and terrorists at the Arihal village in the Pulwama district of Jammu and Kashmir. According to officials, the exchange of fire is

currently underway between terrorists and the joint security team. Encounter started in Arihal village of District Pulwama. Police and security forces on the job. Further details shall follow, the official X handle of Kashmir Zone Police.

Israel ignored information about Hamas attack for a year

New York : The New York Times claimed that Israel knew about the plans of the Hamas Group to attack Israel, but did not take it seriously. Israeli military and intelligence officers believed that attacking Israel is difficult for Hamas. The New York Times published a report saying that the information to Israel was available through e-mails and secret documents.

The leading American newspaper analysed the documents and said Jericho Wall did not mention the date of the attack (Oct 7). Description of breaking boundaries around Gaza, capturing cities in Israel, and attacking prominent military sites were part of the Hamas design.
