THE CONGRESS has completed the process of candidate selection for the 26 Lok Sabha seats in Gujarat though the names will be made public only before the date for filing of nominations, senior party leader Shaktisinh Gohil said on Monday. The process had started early and included taking the opinion of workers, meetings of the Pradesh Election Committee, the screening and scrutiny committees, and discussions among senior leaders, said Gohil, who is the party's state unit chief.

Nayara Energy exports drop 10% in 2023 as 'domestic demand surges'

New Delhi: Nayara Energy, India's largest private fuel retailer, saw petroleum product exports drop by 10 per cent in 2023 as it supplanted more products domestically to meet the fuel demands of a growing economy, sources said. Nayara, which operates a 20 million tonne a year oil refinery at Vadinar and a network of over 6,500 petrol pumps, exported 6.21 million tonne of petroleum products, including jet fuel, gasoil (diesel) and gasoline (petrol) between January 2023 and December 2023, down 10 per cent year-on-year. This was primarily because of larger consumption at home. The company is catering to the domestic market through institutional business, sales to other oil companies and its own retail chain. Of all the petroleum products Nayara produced, 68 per cent were sold within the country and the remaining 32 per cent of products, including ATF, gasoil and gasoline were exported, sources said.

Rs 1 CRORE 'SEIZED' FROM VADODARA HOUSE

Indian women cricket team's former coach booked, say police

INDIAN WOMEN'S cricket team former coach Tushar Arothe has been booked after cash worth Rs 1 crore was seized from his house in the Pratapgunj area of Vadodara.

The police's Special Operations Group (SOG) raided Arothe's residence on Saturday and found "grey bags" containing Rs 1.01 crore, a press release from the police stated Sunday. Arothe had "no satisfying explanation" when questioned about the cash, it added.

SOG Inspector V. S. Patel said the cash was seized after receiving a tip-off that "bags of cash had arrived at the apartment of Arothe's son Rishi, who was previously booked in cases of cricket betting and cheating".

Two other accomplices named Vikrant Raipatvar and Amit Janit were also found in possession of cash worth Rs 38 lakh... Arothe said that the money was sent by his son Rushi from Nashik by an Angadia service. On being questioned, Arothe had no satisfactory reply about the huge sum of cash recovered from the residence and therefore, we initiated proceedings against Arothe, Raipatvar, and Janit under CrPc Section 102 (power to seize property)," Patel said. In April 2019, the Vadodara Crime Branch had also arrested 19 people, including Arothe, from a local cafe in the city for alleged betting during an IPL match between Delhi Capitals and Kings XI Punjab. All accused were granted bail by a court. Arothe, a former first-class cricketer for Baroda, was head coach when the Indian women's team reached the World Cup final in 2017, earning him a two-year extension. His term ended prematurely in July 2018 when he resigned after the defeat to Bangladesh in the Asia Cup final following reports of discord within the team. He had also been part of the team's coaching staff between 2008 and 2012.

Four-year-old survives car crash that kills 5 of family

A FOUR-year-old girl on Sunday night survived a car crash, which killed five members of her family. The incident occurred late on Sunday night at the Jambuva junction on NH-48 near Vadodara. Six of a family, aboard a hatchback, were returning from their native village of Nikora in Bharuch when their car rammed a trailer. Four adults and a one-year-old were killed in the accident, said officials. The deceased have been identified as Pragayesh Patel (34), his wife Urvashi (31), his brother Mayur Patel (30) and Mayur's wife Bhumika (28). According to some friends, the Patels were returning

from Nikora village in Bharuch after spending a day at their farm when they met with an accident near Vadodara. Pragayesh's friend Anil Parmar, who was at the SSG Hospital's postmortem department to help relatives with formalities, said, "Both Pragayesh and Mayur worked as medical representatives at a firm. They had gone to Nikora village, where they own farmland, and were returning late at night. Their car is said to have rammed a trailer... Pragayesh's one-year-old son, Luv, was also killed on the spot. Only their four-year-old daughter has survived. Her future will be a concern as Pragayesh and Mayur lost both their parents during the pandemic within a week of each other..."

Two Union ministers set to visit state today

Ahmedabad: Union ministers Gajendra Singh Shekhawat and Ajay Mishra will be in Gujarat on Tuesday and Wednesday to take part in various events and interact with people from different walks of life, the ruling BJP said on Monday. In a release, it said Union Minister of Jal Shakti Shekhawat will begin his tour Tuesday from Surendranagar town where he will hold a meeting with office bearers of Kheti Bank and local trade bodies. Later in the evening, he will address a public rally in Dumala village of Ahmedabad district. "On March 6, he would visit

Ambaji temple in Banaskantha district and hold meetings with co-operative leaders associated with Banas Dairy at Sanadar village. In the evening, he will attend a party meeting at Palanpur," it said. Ajay Mishra, Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs, will be in Ahmedabad on Tuesday and meet textile traders and jewellers and attend a programme of non-Gujaratis in Amraiwadi area of the city in the evening. "On the next day, Mishra will attend 'Yuva Samvad' event at Bhat village in Gandhinagar. Later during the day, he will meet local industrialists in Vastral area of Ahmedabad," the BJP release said.
