Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Statement of Standalone Financial Results of Cosyn Limited ('the Company') for the year ended March 31, 2024 being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the Listing Regulations) and both included in the Statement.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, Standalone Financial Results for the year ended March 31, 2024:

- are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended; and
- give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS 34") prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013, ("the Act") read with relevant rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and total comprehensive income and other financial information of the Company for the year ended March 31, 2024.

Basis for Opinion
