The said Business Transfer Agreement was completed on 21 st September, 2015. Before closing of said Business
		Transfer, the Company was directed by the Odisha State Pollution Control Board (OSPCB) to deposit a sum of Rs. 2.11 Cr as per Order dt. 1 st May, 2015 under the Environment Protection Act. The Company had filed a Writ Petition wherein Interim Order was passed directing the OSPCB and CPCB not to take coercive action against the Company.
		After closing of the said Business Transfer, during the process of merger between M/s. Grasim Industries Limited and M/s. Aditya Birla Chemicals (India) Limited approved by the Jharkhand High Court, the present claimant was directed by the OSPCB to deposit Rs. 2.11 Cr and also undertake remediation programme.
