		However, basis our response to the aforesaid notice along with the supporting documents within the given time limit, the Deputy Commissioner of State Tax, Punjab GST Department reviewed our reply and issued an Order (dated 26 th April 2024) by dropping the demand of Rs. 2,41,40,717/- and raising a final demand of Rs. 10,80,86,379/- (comprising Tax: Rs. 5,16,24,612/-, Interest: Rs. 5,12,99,306/-; and Penalty: Rs. 51,62,461/-).	
		The aforesaid Order is open for further submissions before the relevant authorities, and we are in the process of responding within the stipulated time as mentioned in the said Order.
