HC asks govt to reply on governor appointed nomination

Mumbai July 31(UNI) : The Bombay High Court on Monday asked Maharashtra government to file a reply with in 10 days on a PIL challenging ex Governor Bhagat Singh Koshyari's decision on Septemberr 5, 2022 withdrawing the 12 MLC nominations recommended by the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) government in November 2020.

The 12 posts of Member of Legislative Council (MLC), to be nominated by the Governor, have remained vacant for nearly three years.

Advocate General Birendra Saraf, arguing on behalf of state government, told the court that till date there are no new recommendations for the 12 MLC posts before the Governor. The court will next hear the PIL on August 21.

NCP (Ajit Pawar Group) activists hold silent protest

Mumbai, July 31 (UNI) : The office-bearers and activists of NCP (Ajit Pawar Group) on Monday held a silent protest against Manohar alias Sambhaji Bhide, a controversial Hindu right-wing activist, here for making insulting, offending remarks against Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi recently.

A large number of

activists and office bearers of NCP, led by Mumbai divisional NCP working president Narendra Rane, carried out the silent protest by tying black arm bands in front of Mahatma Gandhi's statue near Mantralaya.

Notably, Sambhaji Bhide has always courted controversy by making insulting remarks on national icons.

Police head constable in ACB net in Chhatrapati Sambhajanagar

Chhatrapati Sambhajanagar, July 31 (UNI) : A police head constable was arrested on Monday by Anti-Corruption Bureau while allegedly taking a bribe of Rs 5,000 from a complainant at the Devgaon Rangari police station here. Constable Suresh Devram Shinde, who was attached with the above-mentioned police station, had sought Rs 5,000 as bribe from complainant for not taking action against him and helping him in a case lodged by his brother and sister-in-law at the same police station over a petty issue, an official press release said here.

Reluctant to pay bribe, complainant approached the city unit of ACB, whose team today laid a trap at the same police station and caught red-handed the constable with the bribe money. A case under Prevention of Corruption Act has been registered against Shinde at the same police station, the release added.

Congress leader advises Sharad Pawar ahead of PM award function

Mumbai, July 31 (UNI) : Maharashtra Congress chief spokesperson Atul Londhe said on Monday that if NCP president Sharad Pawar is going to attend a function in Pune, where Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be honoured with the Lokmanya Tilak Award on August one (tomorrow), then he should tell his disciple (Modi) that

whatever the latter is doing is against Tilak's ideology.

In a press statement, he stated that when an alliance has been formed in the name of INDIA against BJP and Narendra Modi across the country, the question of whether Pawar should attend the Prime Minister's programme or not is being discussed. And, Congress state president Nana Patole has already clarified that it

is up to Pawar and his party whether to attend the event or not, he reminded. The Congress leader said that people do not want the Maratha leader to attend the programme of the person who has allegedly threatened the country's democracy and Constitution.

But, even then Pawar Senior still wants to attend the event in Pune, where

PM Modi had earlier described the NCP supremo as his guru, then it is expected that he should remind his disciple that whatever Modi has been doing is against Tilak's ideology, Londhe added,

Congress, progressive political parties stage 'dharna' in Sangli

Sangli, July 31 (UNI) : The district unit of the Congress party, along with other progressive political

parties, staged a 'dharna' agitation here on Monday to protest against alleged controversial statement of

Shiv Pratisthan founder Sambhaji Bhide against Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi recently.

The activists and office-bearers of these parties, led by senior thinker Prof Dr Baburao Gaurav and Congress district president Prthviraj Patil, gathered at Station Chowk area and staged 'dharna' amidst chanting of slogans against Bhide. While addressing the gathering, Dr Gaurav blamed the ruling BJP and other Hindutvavadi Sanghatana leaders for constantly giving such provocative statements and alleged that BJP was trying to bring back Manuvad (the ethos of a society governed by Manusmti) in the country.

Addressing the people

after offering prayers at Shaktipeeth Sheetla Dham Chaukiya, Shivpal said, "We are not people who take political advantage of religious deeds, what we do is subject to our faith. BJP misleads the public by linking its hypocrisy with religion."

He said that when BJP people go to any religious place, it starts running on TV channels a week before the Prime Minister, Chief Minister and Ministers are going to visit on a certain date.

Shivpal said that those who have faith

go to worship without telling anyone.

The SP leader said, "I came to Jaunpur on Sunday as I have faith in Sheetla Mata and sought blessings of the deity without any publicity. Those who have faith in God do not publicise. Those who want to mislead in the name of God, do the work of propagating it even before offering prayers, in which BJP is number one."

He said that the people of BJP have even divided God into castes. "They want to do politics only in the name of religion, they do not care about development, employment and inflation. Corruption, loot, murder, rape crime is at its peak in the BJP government," Yadav said.
