The property is expected to open in FY27 and shall be managed by Carnation Hotels Private Limited, a whollyowned subsidiary and the management arm of Lemon Tree Hotels Limited.

Initially, a small town, Agartala flourished under the rule of the Manikya dynasty and later became a princely state under British colonial rule. The city's markets buzz with activity, offering a diverse array of goods, including handicrafts, textiles, and spices.
