19 Bangladeshi nationals including 10 women arrested from red-light areas Pune

Pune, Sept 1 (UNI) : Social Security Cell (SSC) of Pune police have arrested 19 Bangladeshi Nationals including 10 women involved in prostitution here on Friday.

Sr inspector of SSC Bharat Jadhav said that police have received information about these foreign nationals who were staying illegally in Budhwar Peth areas of city from last few months.Accordingly, we conduct raid in the areas at wee hours today and arrested all 19 Bangladeshi Nationals who came illegally to Pune last three months ago by crossing India- Bangladesh Border.

Jadhav further said that all 19 persons entered India illegally without any valid documents. They have no written permission from the civil authority on the Indo-Bangladesh and leaving in Budhwar which is one of the famous red-light of Maharashtra.Assistant Police Inspector Aniket poet said the team of Security Department conducted raid under the guidance of senior police officers and arrested all 19th accused simultaneously. After verifying them, they confessed that all have illegally entered into India. Police have registered case against all and further investigation still on, said poet.He said action was taken under guidance of Pune police Commissioner Ritesh Kumaar, Joint Commissioner of Police Sandeep Karnik, Upper Commissioner of Police Ramnath Polke, Deputy Commissioner of Police Amol Zende, Senior Police along with other police officials involved in carrying raid.

Only 321 villages can get crop insurance in Aurangabad dist.

Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, Sept 4 (UNI) : Farmers across from 321 villages comparing 20 mandals in the Aurangabad district presently eligible for crop insurance assistance.

Agricultural official sources on Friday said Crops are on the verge of drying up due to lack of rain in the district. The farmer has become vulnerable.

As per rain situation of the district, 20 out of 83 mandals are currently eligible for assistance, but some more mandals may be included in this in a few days.There are 321 villages in 20 circles under insurance compensation.

Decision by Mahayuti government pro-people, pro-farmer: Tatkare

Mumbai, Sept 1 (UNI) : NCP (Ajit Pawar Group) state president Sunil Tatkare on Friday said the decisions taken by the present Maharashtra government are “pro-people and pro-farmer”.

Tatkare was speaking at a meeting in Worli here.

He praised the Eknath Shinde government for being the first in the country to provide insurance cover at one rupee for the benefit of the farmers.

Tatkare said emphasis should be placed on conveying to the people the decisions taken in their interest.

“With a new thinking, we decided to work in the state and the country under the leadership of Ajit Pawar. There is no confusion in this,” he said.

He said the present ruling alliance has set a target of winning all the 48 Lok Sabha seats in the state. “We will definitely work together to achieve this goal.

When we try to work with new ideas, we need to work together. The fight that followed became history,” he said.

Tarkare said there were many challenges before the current state regime in the coming elections.

In recent times, those who have got “political jaundice” are creating illusions by raising the issue of removing Mumbai from Maharashtra. “But the decisions taken through the grand coalition will be in the interest of Mumbai and the state,” he said .

It's impossible to defeat the I.N.D.I.A alliance: Rahul Gandhi

Mumbai, Sept 1 (UNI) : Iterating that parties constituting the I.N.D.I.A alliance represent 60 percent of the country’s population, Congress MP Rahul Gandhi on Friday said it would be impossible for the BJP to win next year’s Lok Sabha polls if the I.N.D.I.A bloc puts up a united front.

“The most important thing to understand is that this stage represents 60 percent of the Indian population. If the parties on the stage unite, it is impossible for the BJP to win the election. So, the task in front of us is to come together in the most efficient way possible,” Gandhi said at a joint media conference of the I.N.D.I.A. alliance after its third conclave here.

Stating that the alliance has taken “two big steps” in its two-day meeting at the country’s commercial capital, Gandhi said “The first step is we have formed

a coordination committee and committees under that committee”.

“And the second step is we have taken a decision that we will expedite all seat sharing discussions and decisions and make them happen as soon as possible,” said the former Congress president.

Alleging that Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s government was extracting money from the county’s poor peope and transferring it to a limited few, Gandhi said the the I.N.D.I.A alliance would come up with an alternative development path.

“The Prime Minister and the BJP are a nexus of corruption and that is the first thing that the INDIA alliance is going to demonstrate and prove. The idea behind the Prime Minister Modi’s government is to extract money from the poor people of this country and transfer it to a limited few and so,

we are going to propose a clear development path.

“We are going to put together a clear set of ideas that will once again involve the poor people, the farmers, the kisans, the workers in the progress of this country,” he said.

Gandhi said after the three meetings of the anti-BJP parties, he could say with confidence that the conclaves have helped build a “huge amount of rapport among all the leaders” in ensuring “all of us work together as one”.

“I can see that there is flexibility among all the leaders, in the way we are approaching things. There are differences of course, but, I am extremely impressed by the way those differences are minimised and ironed out,” he added.Gandhi also alleged that the media in the country has been “chained” and averred that the I.N.D.I.A alliance was working to “free you from

“your chains”.

Shiv Sena (UBT) President and former Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray said the alliance was marching ahead confidently to win the upcoming Lok Sabha elections.

“We are moving ahead step-by-step and the third INDIA meeting was concluded successfully. We are all nation-lovers and we shall fight those who are opposed to the country, you all know who they are,” saidThackeray, who hosted the conclave attended by 28 political parties from all over India.

Without naming the Bharatiya Janata Party, he reiterated that the INDIA bloc will unitedly fight against autocracy, and corruption, combat atrocities in different parts of the country, and work for a ‘new India’.

“We had heard of ‘sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas’, but thereafter, allies were forgotten and friends only benefitted. For years there was ‘loot’, during election time ‘chhoot’ (rollback of gas cylinder prices). We will stop all this,” declared Thacekay, whose party was previously a constituent of the BJP-led

Mumbai police receives 'threat call' to blow up Taj Hotel

Mumbai, Sept 1 (UNI) : Mumbai Police received a 'threat call' claiming two Pakistani citizens would reach the city to blow up the Taj Hotel, official said on Friday.A call was received at the main control room of the Mumbai Police late on Thursday evening from an unknown man, informing them that two men hailing from Pakistan would enter Indian territory. Their plan is to enter Mumbai through the sea route and blow up the city’s famous hotel, he said on the call.

NDA. Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) President Sharad Pawar alleged that the Bharatiya Janata Party-led government was “ignoring” the problems faced by the people – the farmers, youth, workers and others.

“Now everybody is unhappy with the BJP to whom they had given power...

The government does not have its feet on the ground,” said Pawar. Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal described the BJP as the most “arrogant” and “corrupt” party to come to power post independence.

Describing the unity among the constituents of the alliance as the unity of the country’s 140 crore people, he cautioned that “misleading news about fissures in our unity may be planted, but we are together”. Bihar Chief Minister and JD(U) chief Nitish Kumar said the media was now controlled by the BJP. “But we will give them freedom”.

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister and DMK chief M K Stalin, who spoke in Tamil, appreciated the unity that exists among all the I.N.D.I.A alliance partners.
