'Will tackle pollution faster than Beijing'

IN HOUSE Javadekar tells Parliament that his govt will solve the air quality problem of NCR within 15 years; says pollution is not a political issue as everybody breathes the same air

NEW DELHI: Union environment minister Prakash Javadekar emphasised in the Lok Sabha on Friday that the NDA government would resolve the air quality problem in Delhi in less than 15 years — the time Beijing took to curb a similar problem.

"Beijing took 15 years to solve the pollution problem, we will take less time compared to them and for which we will do a united effort," Javadekar said during his reply to the question on air pollution and climate change in the Lok Sabha.

He said, "India will lead in climate change and get free from air pollution very soon."

The minister called upon lawmakers to pledge to plant seven trees for their entire life. He said carbon emission has been reduced by 22% and would be further cut to 35% in the near future.

The minister informed the House that the government was "working on a national clean air programme and spending money in city-specific schemes".

Observing that pollution was not a political issue because everybody breathes the same air, he said the Centre's work in this direction had faced 2,000 industries to shift to PMG and around 3,000 brick kilns on 'zig zag' technology.

On the Delhi government's allegation that stubble burning was a major reason of pollution in Delhi-NCR, the minister said these states should deal with these issues.

BS petrol and diesel will be available from April next year, the minister said, adding all industries had been directed to produce vehicles complying with BS-6 technology, which will decrease vehicle pollution up to 10%.

In the last four years, Javadekar said, around 13,000 square metres of green cover had been increased. Green cover of only two countries, including India, was increasing in the world, he said.

The minister said all industries had been directed to adopt new technologies. "We have put 3,500 maximum pollution-producing industries on a 24x7 monitoring machine. We keep checking the places where water of these industries is discharged."

"So far, we have reduced the intensity of acid rain by 22% and our target is 35% very soon."

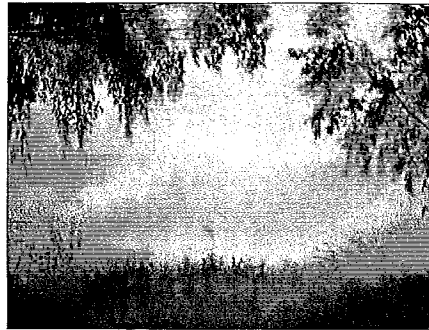
Mentioning that the solution comes when the basic of the problem is recognised, he said the Air Quality Index (AQI) was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2015 for this very purpose. "The AQI survey is done on 700 locations in 34 cities across India."

Stressing the need to develop a mentality of planting trees, Javadekar said the government was presenting in the committee with scientists all together and together work to solve the problem.

In Cop-14 Summit on land degradation issue, organised here in last month, he said the prime minister had announced India would take steps to make 26 million hectares (2.6 crore) barren land green in the next 10 years. "We are moving on our own path, now the world has to move."

Season of stubble burning almost over, says Met dept

NEW DELHI: After almost two months of shrouds of smoke from Punjab and Haryana affecting Delhi's air quality, crop stubble burning activities are almost over, said a senior state government official on Friday.

On Friday, the winter sowing in the national capital was north westerly, which brings pollutants from crop stubble burning from Punjab and Haryana.

"India's version will be clear in the Cop-26 Summit in Spain next month. India will say it has been following what promises were made during Paris summit and every country will have to do it."

Stating that the problem of pollution was not in plants, trees, he said that there were four reasons behind the toxic air. These include industry, vehicles, dust and biomass burning.

However, data shows that there are still four districts, which are estimated to contribute to nearly 4% of total stubble burning incidents in Punjab.

These districts are Bahaudin, Barnala, Mairwa, Sangur and Mansa.

"During the weekend, crop burning cases are likely to pick up a little. But overall, the cases are controlled," senior official of the agriculture department said.

Scientist at the India Meteorological Department (IMD) also said the effect of farm fires in the capital's pollution levels had been negligible over the past two days.

"The season is nearly over. Burning activities spotted over the last two days have been very less and that is because the harvest season is almost over. The wind direction is more westerly, but the speed has improved since afternoon and that their quality will improve in the coming days," senior IMD scientist said.

Air 'very poor', may improve next week

NEW DELHI: Delhi's air quality improved marginally on Friday but remained in the 'very poor' range. The situation is set to improve next week as wind speed is expected to pick up over the weekend, scientists at the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said.

Delhi's overall air quality index (AQI) on Friday was 365 as against the 368 recorded on Thursday. Despite the overall AQI levels improving, in the evening, the air quality turned dangerous at some stations.

At 7pm on Friday, the PM2.5 (the particulate matter with diameter less than 2.5 micrometres) levels were 192µg/m3, nearly three times higher than the acceptable limit of 60µg/m3. "The wind speed in the afternoon was around 10-km/h, the

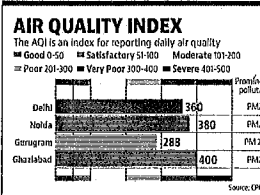
NEW DELHI: A 30-year-old cashier was robbed of around ₹15 lakh by four unidentified men in Geeta Colony on Friday afternoon.

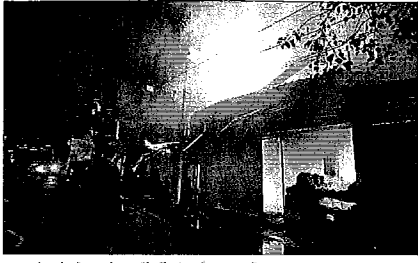
