Report on the audit of the Financial Results

### Opinion:

- 1. We have audited the accompanying statement of quarterly and year to date financial results of Mystic Electronics limited (the "Company") for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 and for the year ended March 31, 2023 ("Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
