MPSC should clear confusion regarding implementation of new syllabus: Londhe

Mumbai, Feb 10 (UNI) : The state government has recently announced the decision to implement the revised syllabus of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) from 2025 instead of 2023. Despite the announcement, there is no clarity about this decision by the MPSC, says Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) Chief Spokesperson Atul Londhe on Friday.

In his letter to Chief Minister Mr Londhe said CM should issue instructions to the MPSC to clear this confusion by issuing a press statement. Two days ago the commission announced that agriculture, forest, engineering exams will be conducted in descriptive mode from 2023 onwards, this has led to confusion among candidates.

Mr Londhe further stated that the MPSC has recently changed the main examination pattern for Class I and Class II Gazetted Officers. It has been decided to conduct these examinations through the commission on the lines of the Central Public Service Commission's main examination and it has been decided to implement it from the same year i.e. from the main examination in 2023. The Congress party had requested the commission to implement this decision from 2025 instead of 2023.

Modi can stay in Mumbai instead of Delhi : Raut

Mumbai, Feb 10 (UNI) : Shiv Sena Uddhav Thackeray group Rajya Sabha MP and spokesperson Sanjay Raut on Friday criticised Prime Minister Narendra Modi saying that he can stay in Mumbai instead of Delhi until the Mumbai Municipal Elections.

Interacting with the mediapersons Mr Raut said, "Mr Modi is coming to Mumbai today to flag off Vande Bharat trains. This is Modi's second visit to Mumbai in the last 21 days. Since Modi's visit is on the eve of municipal elections and said until the Mumbai Municipal Corporation

elections are held.

Until the date of Mumbai Municipal Corporation is fixed, Mr Modi may stay in Mumbai from Delhi. They can take a house in Mumbai or stay in the Raj Bhavan. Because the people of BJP and Shinde group in this Mumbai Maharashtra are not capable to win the municipal corporation.

No 'unparliamentary' words in my speech : Kharge

New Delhi, Feb 10 (UNI) : Leader of Opposition (LoP) in Rajya Sabha, Mallikarjun Kharge on Friday claimed that he did not use any 'unparliamentary' words during his Wednesday's speech in the Upper House, and asked why several of his words were expunged. Raising the matter in the Rajya Sabha for the second consecutive day, Kharge said, "We respect you (Chairman Jagdeep Dhankar). Whatever our anger is, it is against the government not on you."

"You have expunged six points (from my speech). In these points, there is no such point which is 'unparliamentary'," Kharge said, amid chanting of 'Modi, Modi' from the treasury benches. As Kharge started reading the first point of his speech which was expunged, Dhankar said, "Nothing will go on record." "He sent a communication to me. The LoP started reading what I have expunged," the Chairman said, referring to Kharge's letter to him over the matter.

The Prime Minister and His Holiness proceeded towards the main entrance, which is modelled after 'Baab Zuwayla'—a gateway to the old city of Cairo built by the Fatimid imams—from where he entered the campus. They planted a fig tree, which serves as a symbol of growth, renewal, and the flourishing of knowledge.

Two young members of the community presented

Prime Minister Modi with doves, which were released as a gesture of peace and goodwill.

The Prime Minister then unveiled the inaugural plaque and officially inaugurated the Arabic Academy with a ceremonial untying of the ribbon.

The Prime Minister was given a tour of the campus to take him through the history, heritage and educational values of the Bohra community. Around 500 students and faculty members were situated at various locations along the Prime Minister's route throughout the campus to greet the PM and engage with him.

The Prime Minister then visited Iwan Taheri, the Ceremonial Hall of the campus where dignitaries and members of the Dawoodi Bohra community from India and abroad were seated. His Holiness presented the Prime Minister with a traditional shawl as a symbol of his gratitude and appreciation.

Modi's visit to Mumbai will have no impact: Nana Patole

Mumbai, Feb 10 (UNI) : Taking pot-shots at Prime Minister Narendra Modi for his second visit to Mumbai on Friday in less than a month, the Congress on Friday said the development indicates that elections are round the corner. Modi doesn't remember Mumbai, Maharashtra without elections. Inauguration of Metro in January and now flagging off Vande Bharat Railway is just an excuse, said MPCC president Nana Patole here.

He said Modi's visit does not make any difference, but on his second trip to Mumbai within a month, the Prime Minister was expected to

talk about issues in Maharashtra, but he again disappointed. Patole said while he is happy that Modi is coming to Mumbai, but it seems the prime minister is not aware of the issues in Maharashtra.

Will take action under state Journalists Act against Amberkar: Samant

Kolhapur, Ratnagiri, Feb 10 (UNI) : Maharashtra industry minister Uday Samant on Friday said that the state government would take action against suspected accused Pandharinath Amberkar under the state Journalists Act, in the murder case of Rajapur journalist Shashikant Warise.

Talking to reporters at the district collector's office in Ratnagiri, Samant said the inquiry into the incident has been transferred to the sub-divisional police officer and the government would stand

by the deceased journalist's family and everything possible will be done for them.

"After receiving information about the incident, we immediately instructed the police to take strict action against the culprit. Warise was allegedly knocked down by a car on February 6 morning in Rajapur. Meanwhile, suspected accused Amberkar, who is now in district hospital custody, complained of chest pain and high blood pressure and was shifted to the district civil hospital.
