- 2 The Company is primarily engaged in the business of cultivation, manufacture and sale of tea and is managed organisationally as a single unit. Accordingly, the Company is a single business segment company.
- 3 As the Company is engaged in business of cultivation, manufacture and sale of tea (single business segment), which is seasonal in character, figures for the quarter and six months ended 30th September, 2018 should not be construed as indicative of likely result for year ending 31st March, 2019.
- 4 Cost of materials consumed represents mainly Green Leaf purchased from third parties.

TOTAL - EQUITY AND LIABILITIES

- 5 On 30th May, 2018, the Board of Directors of the Company approved buy back of Company's equity shares for an amount not exceeding Rs. 10000 lakhs (being less than 10% of the Equity share capital and free reserves of the Company as on 31st March, 2018) from the existing shareholders from the open market through stock exchanges. Till 30th September, 2018, the Company has bought back 3027082 equity shares, which have been extinguished subsequently.
- 6 On 9th August 2018, the Shareholders of the Company approved to sell specified assets of certain tea estates of the Company. In line with such approval,
- a) During the quarter, the Company has sold certain specified assets of 12 Tea Estates, with effect from 1st July 2018, for an aggregate consideration of Rs. 47200 lakhs. Profit on sale of such assets amounting to Rs. 14669 is shown as Exceptional Item in the above results.
- b) In September 2018, the Company has also entered into Memorandum of Understanding/Term Sheet with proposed buyers to sell certain specified assets of another 8 Tea Estates for an aggregate consideration of Rs. 32361 lakhs, subject to due diligence by the proposed buyers and necessary approvals. Pending such approvals etc. the final binding agreements with the proposed buyers are under negotiation. The carrying value of those specified assets of the Tea Estates as on 30th September 2018 has been reclassified from Property Plant & Equipment to "Assets held for sale" and the agreed sale consideration is higher than their carrying value.
- 7 The above results for the quarter and six months ended 30th September, 2018 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on 12th November, 2018 and these have been subjected to a limited review by the Statutory Auditors of the Company.

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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM FINANCIAL RESULTS

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MCLEOD RUSSEL INDIA LIMITED

 We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Financial Results of McLeod Russel India Limited ("the Company") for the Quarter and Six Months ended 30th September, 2018 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5th July, 2016.

This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.

- 2. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
