AAI seeks MoEF nod for expansion of 5 airports

THE AIRPORTS AUTHORITY of India (AAI) has sought various clearances from the ministry of environment and forest (MoEF) for the expansion of five airports, including Vijayawada, Lucknow and Patna, involving an investment outlay of ₹3,258 crore.

According to the minutes of meeting of the latest expert appraisal committee (EAC) under the environment ministry, AAI has sought clearances for Patna, Lucknow, Dehradun and Jabalpur airports. It also requested the ministry to prepare terms of reference for the Vijayawada airport expansion programme.

AAI intends to construct a new terminal building T3 for Lucknow airport after dismantling Terminal 1 to cater to the increasing number of domesticas wellas international passengers as the capacity of the current ones has neared saturation point. A multi-level car parking and allied facilities are also proposed. "The estimated cost of the project (for Lucknow airport) will be approximately ₹1,383 crore.

Based on the information submitted and clarifications provided by the Project Proponent (AAI)... EAC recommended the project for grant of Environmental clearance for Lucknow Airport," the committee said.

AAI plans to set up a new domestic terminal at Jai Prakash Narayan International (JPNI) Airport, Patna, to handle



4.5 million passengers per year with modern amenities on a par with GRIHA-4 rating.

The existing domestic terminal is more than 20-year old and the ATC tower, technical block and administrative offices are housed in the same domestic terminal building.

Initially, the building was designed for 50 lakh passengers per annum. The cost of the project is ₹865 crore, the EAC said. However, the increase in number of flights has seen more passengers travelling per year to about three million and hence the existing building was not sufficient to cater to the present passenger load, it

"In view of the future growth of passengers, it is proposed to construct a new domestic terminal for 4.5 million per annum," the EAC said in case of Patna airport while recommending for the environment clearance with certain

For Vijayawada, AAI has submitted a plan for construction of a new integrated terminal building with allied facilities like surface car parking, utility building, city side fourlane approach road and canopy for passenger facilitation, among others, at an investment outlay of ₹500 crore, the committee said in the

As per current traffic data, Vijayawada airport handled 3.98 lakh passengers in 2015-16. The airport is expected to handle 14.87 lakh passengers by 2021-22.

AAI also proposes to expand the Dehradun airport by constructing a new integrated terminal building and allied facilities at an investment of ₹344.75 crore, while for expansion of the Jabalpur airport, it requested the ministry to reconsider the environment clearance to make the aerodrome suitable for operation of AB-320 type aircraft.

Flipkart deal: Income tax dept to wait till September 7 for Walmart to pay tax

THE INCOME TAX department will wait till September 7 for the settlement of withholding tax by Walmart on payments made to about 44 shareholders exiting e-commerce firm Flipkart before it proceeds in the case, an official has said.

US-based retail giant Walmart had completed acquisition of 77% stake in Flipkart for about \$16 billion in mid-August. As per the provisions of the I-T law, Walmart has to deduct withholding tax on payments made to sellers and deposit it with the Indian authorities on the seventh day of the subsequent month, which falls on September 7.

The Walmart has not yet approached the tax department to ascertain the withholding tax liability, though some shareholders of Flipkart who are exiting the e-commerce company have sought guidance on their tax liability, the officials said.

Under Section 197, seller of shares can obtain withholding tax certificate from the tax department after providing details of the transaction and make a case for availing lower or nil tax rates. The tax rate could be lower in case the non-resident seller invokes provision of the double tax avoidance agreement.

"Walmart still has time till September 7 to deduct and pay withholding tax on payments made to about 44 different shareholders of Flipkart," the official said, adding that the department can only proceed in this case once the deadline for payment of taxes is over.

Once the withholding tax is paid, the tax authorities will

343 infrastructure projects show cost overrun of ₹2.23 lakh crore

AS MANY AS 343 infrastructure projects, each worth ₹150 crore or above, have shown cost overrun of ₹2.23 lakh crore owing to delays and other reasons, a report said.

The ministry of statistics and programme implementation monitors infrastructure projects worth ₹150 crore and above. "Total original cost of implementation of the 1,332 projects was ₹16.27 lakh crore and their anticipated completion cost is likely to be ₹18.5 lakh crore, which reflects overall cost overruns of ₹2.23 lakh crore (13.71% of original cost)," the ministry's latest re- pated cost. But it said the num-



ported cost overrun and 253 time escalation.

According to the report, the expenditure on these projects till April 2018 is ₹6.63 lakh crore, 35.85% of the anticicalculated on the basis of latest schedule of completion.

However, it said the number of delayed projects decreases to 187 if delay is calculated on the basis of latest schedule of completion.
