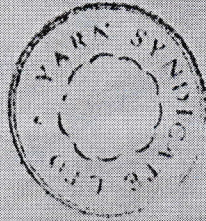

SHARAD PAWAR BATS FOR CASTE CENSUS

MUMBAI: NCP president Sharad Pawar on Wednesday demanded a caste-based census, saying such an exercise was necessary to ensure social equality. Addressing a meeting of the NCP OBC cell, Pawar said everybody should get what is rightfully due to them. "We are not asking anything for free. There is no option but to conduct a caste-based census," the former Union minister said. Pawar said Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes had benefited due to reservations granted to them by the Constitution and similar concessions are required for the Other Backward Classes. "The NCP leader's comments came in the backdrop of demands to restore OBC reservation in local body polls in Maharashtra, where elections are due this year in a number of local self-government institutions. The Supreme Court earlier this year rejected the Maharashtra State Backward Classes Commission's interim report recommending the restoration of 27 per cent reservation for OBCs in local body polls. "To provide concessions, the government should know the exact OBC population and hence a caste-based census was needed," Pawar said. Based on the census figures, justice can be provided to the community, said the NCP leader, whose party is a key constituent in the Shiv Sena-led Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) government.

HC NOTICE TO CENTRE ON PIL SEEKING EQUAL STATUS FOR 'VANDE MATARAM' WITH 'JANA-GANA-MANA'

NEW DELHI [INDIA]: ednesday issued notice to the Central Government on a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) that sought direction to declare that the song 'Vande Mataram', which played a historic part in the struggle for Indian freedom, shall be honoured equally with 'Jana-Gana-Mana' and have equal status. The Bench of Justice Vipin Sanghi and Justice Sachin Datta on Wednesday while issuing a notice to the Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Education, Ministry of Culture, Ministry of Law and Justice and others, also expressed displeasure with the petitioner for going to the press (media) for publicising the matter even before listing. The Court has listed the matter for November 9, 2022. The plea also sought direction to the Centre and State Governments to ensure that 'Jana-Gana-Mana' and 'Vande Mataram' are played and sung in all schools and educational institutions every working day and also to frame guidelines in the spirit of the Constituent Assembly resolution dated January 24, 1950, read with the Judgment passed by the Madras High Court and Supreme Court of India.

ED seeks answer to 5 key points by ex-NSE MD Chitra Ramkrishna

NEW DELHI [INDIA]: In its ongoing probe in the National Stock Exchange (NSE) co-location scam case, the Enforcement Directorate has questioned former NSE Managing Director Chitra Ramkrishna on five key points among others, which are yet to be answered. ED asked about the alleged manipulation of the NSE when Ramkrishna was at the helm of affairs at the bourse, said officials privy to the investigation. The federal agency had asked how the co-location scam could take place when Ramkrishna was holding the post of CEO and MD of the NSE.

The alleged governance lapses in appointing Anand Subramanian as the chief strategic advisor and his re-designation as group operating officer and advisor to Ramkrishna when she was the NSE MD. Subramanian, NSE's former group operating officer, was arrested by the CBI in Chennai on 24 February 2022. The ED investigators also asked about the charges of brokers being given preferential access to the NSE's trading system in the form of a co-location facility through which they bought 'rack space' for their servers. CBI investigation has revealed that these traders obtained faster access to the Exchange's data feed.



According to the officials, the federal agency has also recorded Ramkrishna's statement each time under the criminal sections of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). A total of three Central agencies, including ED, CBI and

Income Tax Department, are investigating the irregularities at the National Stock Exchange. The ED case is based on a CBI FIR registered in 2018 where a brokerage firm was accused of manipulating the house in connivance with NSE office bearers. ED also conducted searches at nine locations across Delhi and Gurgaon, last month, in connection with its money laundering probe into the alleged case. CBI arrested Ramkrishna and Subramanian early this year and they are currently lodged in jail. A chargesheet has also been filed against them in court by the CBI. The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) had launched its probe into the co-location matter in early 2015 after

it was brought to light by a 'whistle-blower' that some brokers were allegedly getting preferential access through the said facility, early login and 'dark fiber' which can allow the trader a split-second faster access to data feed of an exchange. As part of this facility, brokers could place their servers within the stock exchange premises giving them faster access to the markets. Ramkrishna got elevated as MD and CEO of NSE on 1 April 2013 and left the bourse in 2016. The action by the central agencies against Ramkrishna, Subramanian and others was renewed after a report of market regulator SEBI came on February 11.

Kapil Sibal files RS nomination as SP-backed Independent

LUCKNOW/NEW DELHI: Saying that he had resigned from the Congress last week, Kapil Sibal on Wednesday filed his nomination for the Rajya Sabha as an independent candidate from Uttar Pradesh supported by the Samajwadi Party. Sibal, who exited from the Congress is another jolt for the electorally battered party, went to resign from the Congress on May 16 and am no longer a senior Congress leader," he said. Sibal, who has been vocal in his criticism of the Congress leadership, had called for a non-Gandhiist new party chief. "We are all constrained by the fact that we are members of parties and have to abide by the discipline of that party but it is important to have an independent



Sibal told reporters in Lucknow. "I resigned from the Congress on May 16 and am no longer a senior Congress leader," he said. Sibal, who has been vocal in his criticism of the Congress leadership, had called for a non-Gandhiist new party chief. "We are all constrained by the fact that we are members of parties and have to abide by the discipline of that party but it is important to have an independent

voice," the former Union minister told reporters. "We want to make a coalition and oppose the Modi government. We want to create an atmosphere in which we can oppose the BJP. I will personally work towards that," he said. Referring to the 2024 elections, he said there should be an atmosphere where the shortcomings of the Modi government can reach people. Yadav said Sibal is being supported by the Samajwadi Party. "Kapil Sibal is a senior leader and a known lawyer. He had been the Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha member and put his point across well everywhere. I hope he will put his views on big questions of rising inflation and China's, the SP president, who is also leader of opposi-

tion, added. Sibal's resignation comes close on the heels of Sunil Jakhar and Hardik Patel resigning from the Congress, which recently held a 'Chintan Shivir' in Udaipur. Elections for 11 Rajya Sabha seats of Uttar Pradesh are underway. There had been speculation that the SP could field Sibal as a Rajya Sabha candidate. He was the lawyer who secured senior SP leader Azam Khan's bail. Khan had been in Sitapur jail for over 27 months in various cases lodged against him in Rampur. The SP has a strength of 111 in the 493-member assembly and can send three members to the Upper House of Parliament. The BJP with 235 members can send eight.

Chinese visa scam: ED files money laundering case against Karti Chidambaram

NEW DELHI [INDIA]: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has filed a money laundering case in the alleged Chinese visa scam case involving Congress MP Karti Chidambaram, officials said on Wednesday. The ED's action came amid inputs that the Congress MP is likely to join the investigation at Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) headquarters in Delhi, soon. "The ED has filed a case under the criminal sections of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, taking cognizance of a recent First Information Report registered by the CBI in the case, officials added. It is alleged that Karti Chidambaram received Rs 50 lakh to illegally facilitate visas for 263 Chinese nationals to complete a power project in Punjab. The CBI alleged that the MP "misused his influence" in the home ministry in 2011 and "con-



spired" with the co-accused to devise a "back-door way to defeat the purpose of the ceiling" on work permits imposed by the ministry. Karti's father and senior Congress leader P Chidambaram was home minister in 2011. P Chidambaram has not been named as an accused in the FIR. Besides the MP, the CBI has booked four other people including Karti Chidambaram's chartered accountant S. Bhaskararaman, Vikas Makheria, representative of Talwandi Sabo Power Ltd, a Matsya-based private company, and Bell Tools, Mumbai along with unknown public servants and private individuals.

Int'l river conclave in Guwahati from May 28-29



GUWAHATI: An international river conference to articulate collective vision of cooperation in the Bay of Bengal and Southeast Asian region will take place in Assam's Guwahati from May 28-29, officials said on Wednesday. The third edition of the conclave, 'NADI' (Natural Allies in Development and Interdependence), will be organised by Shillong-based think tank Assam for the region in collaboration with the Union External Affairs Ministry, Act East Policy Affairs Department of the Assam government, North Eastern Council and other partners. The Bangladesh Foundation for Regional Studies is the country partner for the event and the International Union for Conservation of Nature, IIT Guwahati and Guwahati University are knowledge partners. A well planned collaboration with the states of Northeast and neighbouring countries on management of shared waters can alleviate disasters to a large extent and cat-

apult the region to being a hub of connectivity and green commerce," Asian Conclave Executive Director Sabayasachi Dutta told reporters here. The conference will focus on the region south of Himalayas - from Ganga, Brahmaputra to Mekong as a continuity of river basins with common challenges that require close cooperation beyond political borders. The two-day event will be inaugurated by Union External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar, while dignitaries such as Bangladesh Foreign Minister A K Abdul Momen, Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma and high commissioners and ambassadors of several countries will be present, Dutta said. "Nirmala Sitharaman, Union Minister of Finance of India, will deliver the valedictory address of the conclave on May 29," he said. The conference is aimed at building confidence in the key role of Northeast in taking forward India's strategic initiative for energy and water security in the neighbourhood and the Bay of Bengal region leading towards a vibrant and secure Indo-Pacific, Dutta said. "NADI uses the symbols and narratives of our shared rivers and shared waters to encourage shared ideas on collaboration with emphasis on 5Cs - Connectivity, Culture, Commerce, Conservation and Collaboration - in the Ganga-Brahmaputra-Meghna basin," he added.

Life comes full circle for Yasin Malik

NEW DELHI: From a Pakistan-trained militant to one of the prominent separatist faces in Kashmir, life has come full circle for chief of the banned Jamaa and Kashmir Liberation Front (JKLF) Yasin Malik who was in limelight for varied reasons over the past three decades of turmoil in the erstwhile reserve border state. The 56-year-old Malik, who has been sentenced to a life term by an NIA court here, has been in and out of jail several times dating back to his student activism days before the onset of militancy in 1990. Having renounced the path of violence and donned the political cloak in 1994, Malik, who is married to a Pakistani artist and has a 10-year-old daughter, had announced Gandhian way of protest after his release and was perceived to be a moderate voice in the separatist camp. He was arrested in early 2019 in connection with a 2017 terror-funding case registered by National Investigation Agency (NIA). Born on April 3, 1966 in Maisuma locality in the heart of Srinagar, Malik is also facing trial in the much-publicized

abduction case of Rubaiya Sayeed, daughter of the then Union home minister Mufti Mohammad Sayeed in 1989, and an attack by JKLF militants on IAF personnel in Srinagar that left four dead and many others injured in 1990. Malik started his anti-national activities at a very young age in 1980s when he formed 'Jais party' which was involved in an attempt to disrupt the 1983 cricket match between India and West Indies in the Sher-e-Kashmir Stadium in Srinagar besides staging a protest against the hanging of JKLF founder Mohammad Maqbool Bhat in Delhi's Tihar Jail on February 11, 1984. After undergoing detention for months together on different occasions, Malik's activities increased after his Talaq was pronounced by Islamic Students League (ISL) that campaigned vigorously for Muslim United Front (MUF) candidates in the 1987 assembly elections. The MUF candidates including Muhammad Yousof Shah lost the elections amid allegations of mass rigging. Shah alias Syed Sallahuddin is now the supreme commander of banned Hizbul Mujahideen based in Pakistan-occupied

Kashmir (PoK). Both Shah and Malik were prominent faces among many others arrested for several months in the aftermath of the elections without a formal charge. After his release, Malik was among the first batch of youths who crossed the Line of Control (LoC) into PoK for arms training in 1988 to join JKLF. Malik along with Haneed Sheikh, Ashfaq Wani and Javed Mir formed the core group of the JKLF. While Wani died in a gunfight with security forces in May 1990, Mir was captured in an injured condition in August 1990 and remained imprisoned till May 1994. Sheikh and six other JKLF militants were killed at Ali Kadai in downtown Srinagar on November 19, 1992, while Mir is now heading a separate faction of JKLF. After his release on bail in May 1994, Malik declared an indefinite unilateral ceasefire to follow non-violent struggle for so-called 'independence' of Jammu and Kashmir from both India and Pakistan. Pakistan-based JKLF founder Amanullah Khan removed Malik as the president of the party in 1995.
