REGULATIONS, 2015 (AS AMENDED)**


To the Board of Directors of Supra Pacific Financial Services Limited

1. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

- 1 These financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of Indian Accounting Standard ("Ind AS") prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 (the "Act") read with relevant rules issued thereunder and the other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended. The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on February 10, 2025. Statutory Auditors of the Company have carried out limited review of the aforesaid results.
- 2 The Code on Wages, 2019 and Code on Social Security, 2020 ("the Codes") relating to employee compensation and post employment benefits that received Presidential assent have not been notified. Further, the related rules for quantifying the financial impact have not been notified. The Company will assess the impact of the Codes when the rules are notified and will record any related impact in the period the Codes becomes effective.
- 3 Consequent to the adoption of Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') as notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015 from April 1, 2019, the impairment losses have been determined and recognised under the expected credit loss method also considering any applicable guidance/ clarifications/ directions issued by the Reserve Bank of India or other regulators as and when they are issued and are applicable.
- 4 The Company's main business is financing activities. All activities are carried out within India. As such there are no separate reportable segments as per Indian Accounting Standard 108 (Ind AS) on "Operating Segments".
