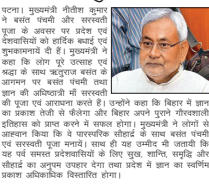

# 29 likely to be elected to RS unopposed

**NEW DELHI:** All 29 candidates announced so far by six parties for the February 27 Rajya Sabha elections are set to win unopposed as none of the parties have put up any extra nominees yet to trigger a contest.

Fifty-six seats of the Upper House will go to the polls later this month to fill up vacancies that will arise in April.

As on Tuesday, six parties including the Bharatiya Janata Party, Trinamool Congress, Samajwadi Party, Janata Dal (United), Biju Janata Dal and YSR Congress Party have announced 29 candidates.

The Congress is yet to announce any names though people aware of the developments said former party chief Sonia Gandhi is likely to file her

papers from Rajasthan. The polling will be held on February 27 and the results will be declared the same day. The last date of filing nomination is February 15.

The Rajya Sabha has already bid farewell to a batch of lawmakers that included former PM Manmohan Singh, BJP chief JP Nadda, former Union minister Prakash Javadekar, Congress leader Abhishek Singhvi and BJD leader Amar Patnaik.

The terms of a number of Union ministers, including Ashwini Vaishnaw, Dharmendra Pradhan, Mansukh Mandviya,

Narayan Rane Rajeev Chadrakhar, and V Muraleedharan are also ending in April.

All eyes are on Maharashtra where Rajya Sabha polls will be held for six seats.

Under the current circumstances, the BJP-led alliance is set to win four seats. But with former Maharashtra CM Ashok Chavan quitting the Congress and joining the BJP on Monday, the number game in the state might change further in favour of the BJP. If a substantial number of Congress lawmakers go away with Chavan, the Congress might lose a Rajya Sabha seat. In Maharashtra, each party needs 42 MLAs to win a seat. The Congress currently has 43 MLAs in the state.

In the BJP list, Sudhanshu Trivedi is, so far, the only sitting lawmaker who has got a fresh nomination. The BJP has

fielded Shamik Bhattacharya, RPN Singh, Chaudhary Tejveer Singh, Sadhna Singh, Amarपाल Maurya, Sangita Balwant, Navin Jain, Mahendra Bhatt, Narayana Krishanasa Bhandage, Subhash Barala, Devendra Pratap Singh, Dharmasheela Gupta, Bhim Singh, Chunnilal Garasiya and Madan Rathore as candidates.

The Trinamool Congress has announced Sagarika Ghose, Sushmita Dev and Nadimul Haque as its candidates. The JD(U) announced Nitish Kumar's trusted aide Sanjay Jha's candidature while the BJD fielded Debashish Samantray and Subhashish Kuntia.

The Samajwadi Party retained Jaya Bachchan and nominated Ramjilal Suman and Alok Ranjan. YSR Congress Party fielded YV Subba Reddy, G Babu Rao and M Raghunadha Reddy.

## BJP K'TAKA CHIEF SLAMS STATE GOVT FOR 'FAILURE' TO FULFIL PROMISES

**BENGALURU:** Karnataka BJP president B Y Vijayendra on Wednesday hit out at the Congress government for its "failure" to fulfil its poll promises other than taking steps on the five guarantees.

He said the Congress should be held accountable for the poverty in the country which could not elevate the status of the poor during its 60 years of rule at the Centre and in states.

"We are not opposed to the five Guarantees but my basic question is that the Congress had ruled the Centre and the state for 55 years to 60 years. Who is accountable for those who remained poor even after so many decades of independence? It is the Congress only. If a farmer is struggling for two square meals, it is due to the Congress," the Shikaripura MLA said during a discussion in the Karnataka Assembly.

Vijayendra said the benefits of the five guarantees have not yet reached even 30% of beneficiaries. He said the Congress had made a poll promise of giving a pay of ₹15,000 per month to the Anganwadi workers and ₹10,000 per month to the Anganwadi assistants but even today the government has not fulfilled it.

## Surya Namaskar in schools: HC dismisses petition against order

**JAIPUR:** The Rajasthan high court on Wednesday dismissed the petition filed by the Rajasthan Muslim Forum challenging the Rajasthan government's recent order that mandated Surya Namaskar during the assembly at every school, said the official familiar with the matter.

"The forum's petition was dismissed by the court due to technical issues that the forum is not a registered organization and therefore they cannot file such a petition as an organisation, as per the rules," said Saadat Ali, the advocate for the forum.

The HC's order read, "The petitioners want to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file a fresh writ petition. The petition is dismissed accordingly with liberty as aforesaid."

The state secondary education board on January 23 ordered all the government schools to organise Surya Namaskar on the day of Surya Saptami on Thursday. The order also further mandated the schools to make it regular practice for all the students during the assembly as the "sunlight is the best source of Vitamin D which will

good for the students' health."

Meanwhile, challenging the government's decision, two petitions were lodged in the high court on Monday ahead of the Thursday's Surya Namaskar programme in which the government also "committed to make a world record" as per the order.

While the Muslim forum has lodged a petition as an organisation, an advocate of Qashif Zubairi also filed a private petition seeking a ban on the order that "mandates Surya Namaskar".

Though the forum's petition was dismissed due to technical issues, the court gave another date for the hearing of Qashif's petition on February 20.

However, responding to the development, the general secretary of the forum and also one of the petitioners Muhammad Nazimuddin said, "There is neither point of filing a fresh petition now nor having the next hearing date as the Surya Namaskar programme will be conducted tomorrow (February 15) without any objection. The government cannot force someone to do it."

Education minister Madan Dilawar said, "Everyone knows that Sun God gives light to everyone, removes darkness from everyone's life and its light protects us from many diseases. Worshipping him is important. It's just a worship."

"The honourable high court also knows that the Sun doesn't discriminate against anyone and it is important to bow down to the one who is giving life to everyone. We will perform Surya Namaskar early tomorrow morning," he added.

## Farmers' protest exposed Modi, says Rajasthan ex-CM Gehlot

**JAIPUR:** Farmers' protest, which was started through a mega march 'Delhi Chalo' on Tuesday, exposed the real character of the Prime Minister Narendra Modi, said former chief minister of Rajasthan, Ashok Gehlot.

"Modi was my Gujarat counterpart when I was the CM in Rajasthan a few years ago. He used to advocate for the MSP law and also press our United Progressive Alliance (UPA)-led government at the Centre to implement it immediately. But, why didn't he do it in the last 10 years after becoming the Prime Minister?" Gehlot questioned.

Taking a dig at the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) government, he said, "Farmers are our 'Annadata'. Such a situation has never arrived where the farmers have to take the roads, demanding their rights. Over 600 of them were also martyred in the last protest held in 2021."

Referring to the fierce clash between the police and the protesting farmers on the Haryana-Delhi-Punjab border on Tuesday, he said, "Is it a way to treat the farmers? Any government should make it a practice to bow down before the people for the welfare of the country. But, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) government pushed the farmers to hold the protest again. Wasn't the last two years (after the 2021 protest) enough to bring the MSP law?"

Recalling the vision of the former Prime Minister Jawahar Lal Nehru, he stated, "He was far sighted which enabled him to take a slew of welfare works for the country, including the farmers. But the BJP doesn't even want to take his name. Rather, they are busy removing such names from the history. What else can you expect from BJP?"

Meanwhile, the former deputy chief minister and senior Congress leader Sachin Pilot also termed the farmers' protest as a reflection of the BJP government's "ego".

"Their ego and arrogance are not letting them bring the MSP law despite the farmers protesting several times. While Congress is planning how to stay committed to bring MSP law if it comes to the power, the BJP failed to do it despite being at the Centre for 10 years," said Pilot.

Slamming the government's move to bar the farmers from protesting by deploying police force, Pilot added, "The government should have fulfilled their promises. But they failed. Now, they are trying to suppress the farmers' voices after they took to the roads, seeking their right."

Responding to the Congress leaders, the Ajmer MP and the

state president of the BJP's Kisan Morcha, Bhagirath Chaudhary said, "Congress should never talk about farmers' welfare. It's only Modi and his government who increased the MSP rate, the grant under PM Kisan Nidhi. He is working tirelessly to double the farmers' income. He is the one who made the ERCP possible in Rajasthan. What did Gehlot do in his 15-year-tenure?"

**JAIPUR:** Ahead of the Lok Sabha election, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) is set to launch a 10-day beneficiary contact programme in Rajasthan from March 25.

In addition, Union home minister Amit Shah will arrive in Rajasthan on February 20 to review BJP's preparations for Lok Sabha elections.

Shah will visit Bikaner division where he will hold meetings with BJP workers and leaders and take stock of programmes and campaigns planned by the party, said state BJP president CP Joshi.

He said, the BJP will carry

out a beneficiary contact campaign from February 25 to March 5 under which workers will meet beneficiaries, and put stickers of Prime Minister Narendra Modi on the houses of each beneficiary.

Joshi said, the party carried

out a Gaon Chalo campaign last week where all leaders spent 24 hours in a village, interacting with villagers and taking feedback about government working.

Joshi and BJP national general secretary Sunil Bansal took meetings of workers at the BJP office in Jaipur on Wednesday.

Joshi said Bansal took three back to back meetings with Lok Sabha incharges, and coordinators.

"Sunil Bansal reviewed the programmes and campaigns planned by the party for the Lok Sabha. He also virtually interacted with incharges of the Atal Sanvad Kendras in the state. He asked about campaigns planned by the state BJP and their implementation," said Joshi.

During his visit to Rajpura hospital, Punjab Congress chief Amrinder Singh Raja Warring arranged a conversation between Gandhi and the farmers over a mobile phone.

The Punjab authorities have raised an objection with the Haryana authorities for the use of a drone for dropping tear gas shells inside the Punjab territory, said a senior official on Wednesday.

On Tuesday, the farmers had clashed with Haryana Police personnel at two border points

between the states, facing tear gas shells and water cannons as they tried to break the barricades blocking their protest march to the national capital.

The Samyukta Kisan Morcha (Non-Political) and the Kisan Mazdoor Morcha are spearheading the 'Delhi Chalo' agitation to put pressure on the Centre for their demands, including a law on MSP for crops and loan waivers.

During their protest on February 13 at the Shambhu border, the farmers, with the help of tractors, managed to remove some of the cemented barricades and iron nails which were part of the elaborate arrangements made by the Haryana authorities to prevent protesters from heading to Delhi.

Twenty-four police personnel, including a deputy superintendent of police, were injured as protesters hurled stones at them, officials said.

The Haryana government on Tuesday had extended the suspension of mobile internet services, bulk SMS and dogle services in seven districts - Ambala, Kurukshetra, Kaithal, Jind, Hisar, Fatehabad and Sirsa till February 15.

That Sonia Gandhi chose to contest from Rajasthan and not from a southern state like Telangana or Karnataka, where the party is also comfortably placed to win, is also a signal that the Congress' first family is not abandoning the Hindi-heartland.

Gandhi's decision to opt for the Rajya Sabha is an admission of a "looming defeat" of the party in the upcoming Lok Sabha polls, the BJP said.

Commenting on the development, BJP IT department head Amit Malviya in a post on X said, "After Congress' crushing defeat in Amethi, Rae Bareilly was next. Sonia Gandhi's decision to opt for Rajya Sabha is an admission of a looming defeat." Malviya said the Gandhis have now deserted their "every supposed stronghold" with the former Congress president deciding to take the Rajya Sabha route instead of contesting the Lok Sabha elections from her family pocket borough Rae Bareilly.

"The Congress will draw a blank in UP, despite 11 seats offered by the SP (Samajwadi Party)," the BJP leader said.
