- 5. The figures for the corresponding three months and six months ended September 30, 2018 are approved by the Board of Directors and were subject to special purpose audit by the auditors for inclusion in the information memorandum filed with relevant stock exchanges for listing of the equity shares of the Company.
- 6. Figures for the previous periods have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary to conform to the current period's classification.

We did not review the interim financial results of 8 subsidiaries included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial results reflect total assets of Rs. 5,596.40 crore as at September 30, 2019, total revenues of Rs. 1,106.76 crore and Rs. 2,184.60 crore for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively, total net profit after tax of Rs. 20.48 crore and Rs. 53.38 crore for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and total comprehensive income of Rs. 48.34 crore and Rs. 80.31 crore for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and net cash flows of Rs. 1.25 crore for the six months ended September 30, 2019, as considered in the Statement. The consolidated unaudited financial results also includes the Group's share of profit after tax of Rs. Nil and Rs. 0.001 crore for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 and Total comprehensive income of Rs. NIL and Rs. 0.001 crore for the guarter and six months ended September 30, 2019, as considered in the Statement, in respect of an associate, whose interim financial results have not been reviewed by us. These interim financial results have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries and associate, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of these matters.

- The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and taken on record by the Board of Directors at their meetings held on 14th November, 2019. The Statutory Auditors of the Company have carried out a limited review of the said results in terms of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- During the six months, the Company has acquired 64.63% equity stake in Herbolab (india Private Limited ('HIPL'), a Company engaged in the business of manufacturing, distribution, dealing and marketing of ayurvedic products.
- Effective April 01, 2019, the Group has adopted Ind AS 116 Leases and applied the revised standard to all lease contracts existing on April 01, 2019, using the modified retrospective method along with the transition option to recognise Right-of-Use asset (ROU) at an amount equal to the lease liability, except in case of a subsidiary in which the cumulative adjustments has been made to retained earnings, on the date of initial application. Accordingly, previous period information has not been restated, in the results for the current period, Operating lease expenses which were recognised as Other expenses in previous periods is now recognised as depreciation expense for Right-of-use asset and Finance cost for interest accrued on lease liability. Pursuant to above, Profit before tax for quarter ended 30th September 2019 and six months ended 30th September 2019 are reduced by Rs. 4,56 crore and Rs. 7,99 crore respectively and to this extent, results for the three months ended 30th September 2019 and for the six months ended 30th September 2019 are not comparable with previous periods.
- The consolidated figures for the corresponding six months ended September 30, 2018 are approved by the Board of Directors and were subject to special purpose audit by the auditors for inclusion in the information memorandum filed with relevant stock exchanges for listing of the equity shares of the Company. 6
- Figures for the previous periods have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary to conform to the current period's classification.
