## GE T&D India Limited's Second Quarter & Half Year Financial results for 2019-20

New Delhi, India November 05, 2019 — GE T&D India Limited – a GE Group Company, reported on 05 November 2019 its financial results for the second quarter & half year ended on  $30^{th}$  September 2019

- Sales revenue for the quarter is ₹ 8.2 Billion compared to ₹ 9.9 Billion for quarter ended Sep'18.
  For H1'2019-20 revenue is ₹ 15.5 Billion compared to ₹ 21.6 Billion of the H1'2018-19.
- Operating loss (loss before interest, exceptional items and tax) for the quarter at ₹ 61 Million against operating profit of ₹ 944 Million in quarter ended Sep'18. For the H1'2019-20 operating profit (profit before interest, exceptional items and tax) is ₹ 161 Million compared to ₹ 2,361 Million in H1'2018-19.
- Net Loss after tax for the quarter is ₹ 811 Million against net profit of ₹ 515 Million in quarter ended Sep'18. For the H1'2019-20 net loss after tax is ₹ 777 Million compared to net profit of ₹ 1,335 Million in H1'2018-19.
- Order bookings for the quarter is ₹ 6.9 Billion compared to ₹ 7.2 Billion for quarter ended Sep'18. For H1'2019-20 order booking is ₹ 11.1 Billion compared to ₹ 13.3 Billion of the H1'2018-19
