All the members of the Company as on the Cut-off date shall be entitled to vote in accordance with the process specified in this Notice.

Equity shares of the Company are listed and are being traded on BSE and NSE. Presently, the Authorised Share Capital of the Company is Rs. 16,00,00,000/- (Rupees Sixteen Crore only) divided into 1,60,00,000 (One Crore Sixty Lakhs) Equity Shares of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten only) each. The Issued, Subscribed and Paid-Up Capital of the Company is Rs. 10,56,79,460/- (Rupees Ten Crore Fifty Six Lakhs Seventy Nine Thousand Four Hundred and Sixty only) divided into 1,05,67,946 (One Crore Five Lakhs Sixty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty Six only) Equity Shares of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten only) each.

In order to improve the liquidity to the Company's equity shares in the stock market and to make it more affordable for small retail investors and also to broad base the small retail investors, it is proposed to sub-divide each existing equity share of face value of Rs. 10/- into 5 equity shares of face value of Rs. 2/- each. The record date for the aforesaid sub-division of equity shares will be fixed by the Board after the approval of the members is obtained for the proposed sub-division.

The Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on 26th February, 2024 has recommended sub-division (split) of equity shares subject to the approval of the members and all the concerned statutory authorities.

As per the provisions of Section 61 of the Companies Act 2013, approval of the members by way of an Ordinary Resolution is required for sub-division of shares.

The proposed Sub-division of the 1 (One) equity shares of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten only) each into 5 (Five) equity shares of Rs. 2/- (Rupees Two Only) each requires amendment in Capital Clause of Memorandum of Association of the Company.

Accordingly, Clause V of the Memorandum of Association is proposed to be amended as set out in Item No. 2 of the accompanying Notice reflecting the corresponding changes in the Authorized Share Capital of the Company consequent to the proposed Sub-division from Rs. 16,00,00,000/- (Rupees Sixteen Crores Only) divided into 1,60,00,000 (One Crore Sixty Lakhs) Equity Shares of Rs. 10/- (Rupees ten only) each to Rs. 16,00,00,000/- (Rupees Sixteen Crores Only) divided into 8,00,00,000 (Eight Crore) Equity Shares of ₹ 2/- (Rupees Two only) each.

Accordingly, the Board recommends passing of the Resolution set out in Item No. 2 of the accompanying Notice as an Ordinary Resolution. None of the Directors, Key Managerial Personnel or their relatives are in any way, concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the resolution, except to the extent of their respective shareholding, if any, in the Company.
