Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“LODR Regulations”), we wish to inform you that, the Company has received an Order dated July 30, 2024, issued by the Proper Officer (State Tax), Commercial Tax Officer, Department of Commercial Tax, Karnataka, basis the GST audit conducted for Karnataka state for the financial year 2019-20 for a tax demand of Rs. 2,95,204/-, Interest of Rs. 2,19,390/- and penalty of Rs. 29,520/- aggregating to a total demand of Rs. 5,44,114/-.

Based on our assessment, we believe that the said demand is not maintainable, and the Company is in the process of preferring an appeal against the said Order. The Order has no material impact on the financials, operations or other activities of the Company.
