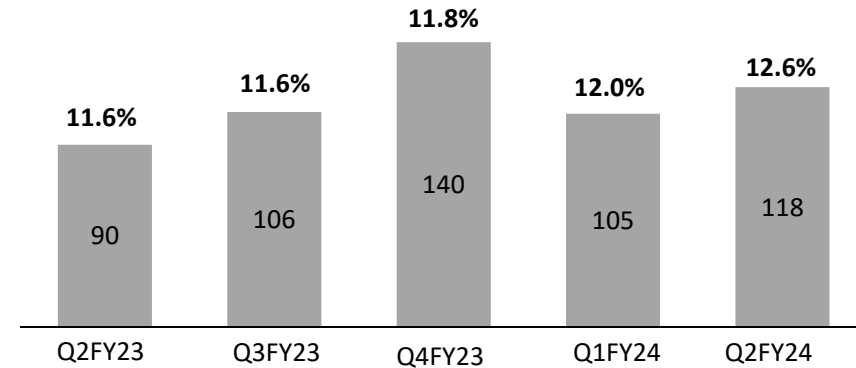

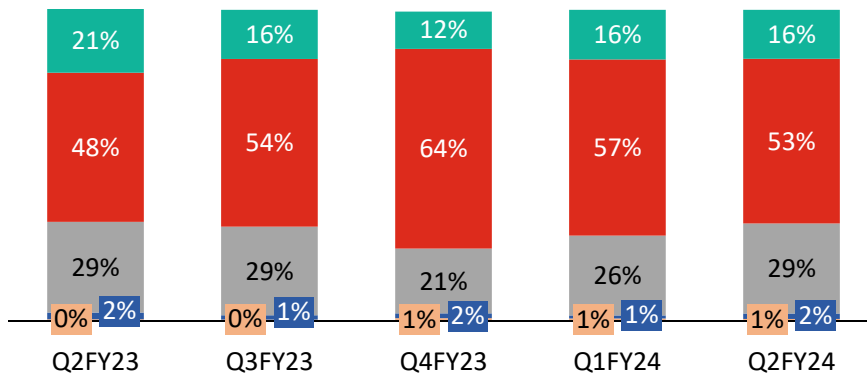
Total Revenue Mix (Rs. Crores)



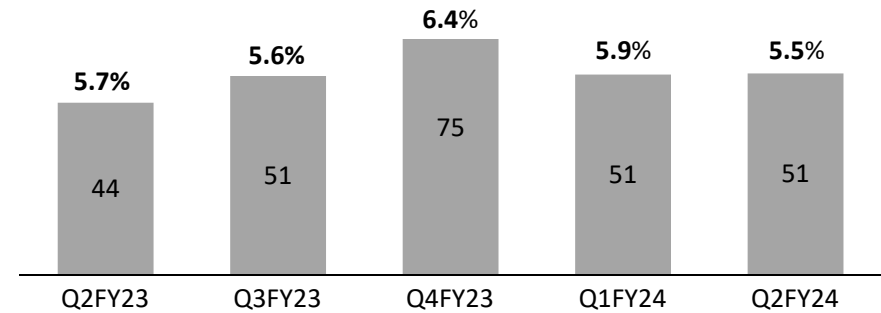
EBITDA (Rs. Crores) & EBITDA Margin



Total Revenue Mix (%)



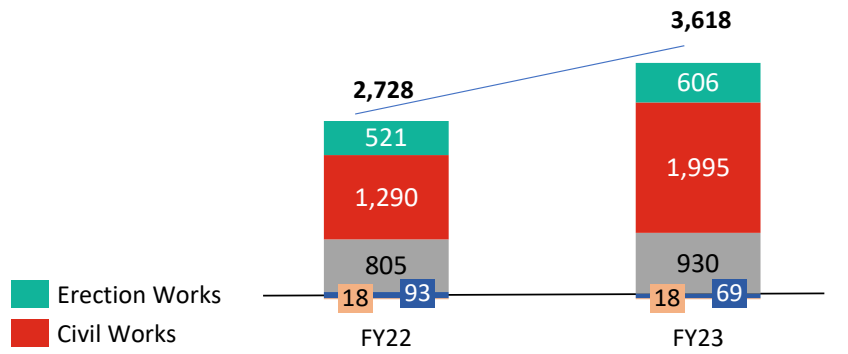

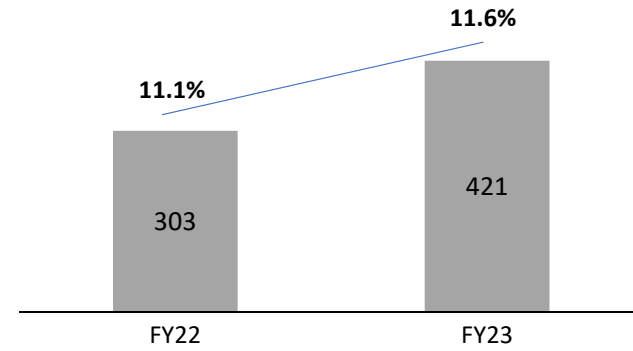

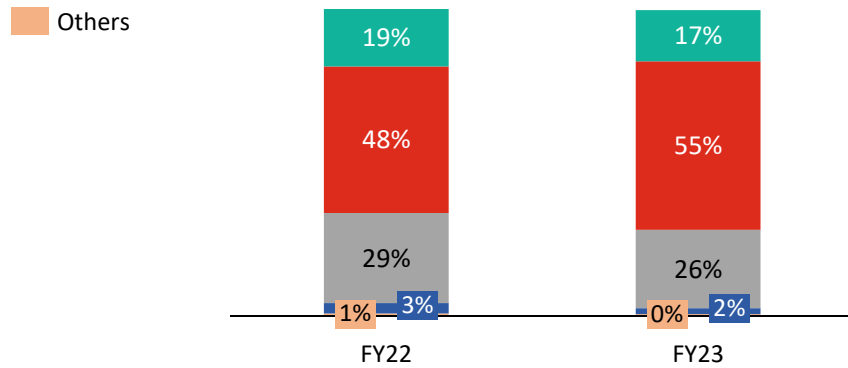

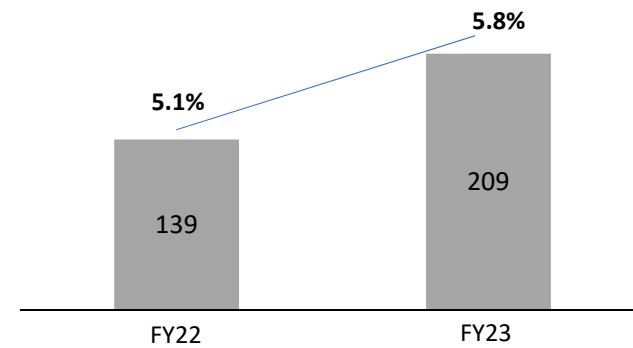
EBITDA (Rs. Crores)

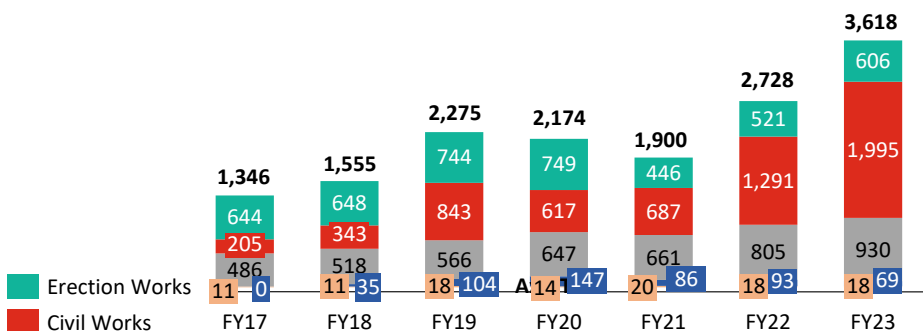

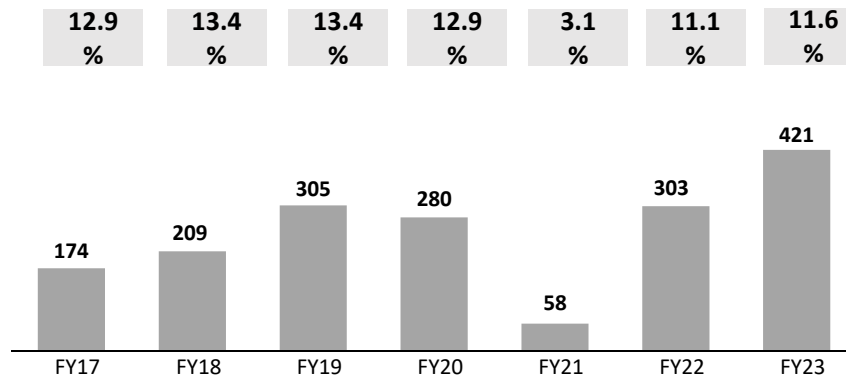

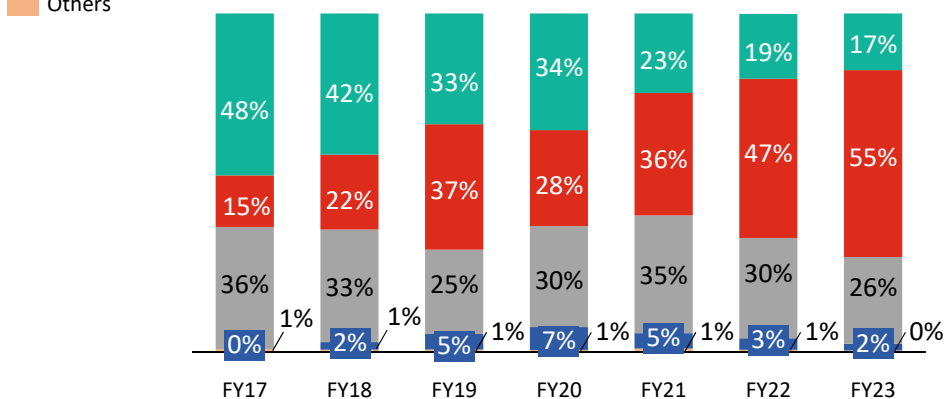
Total Revenue Mix (Rs. Crores)



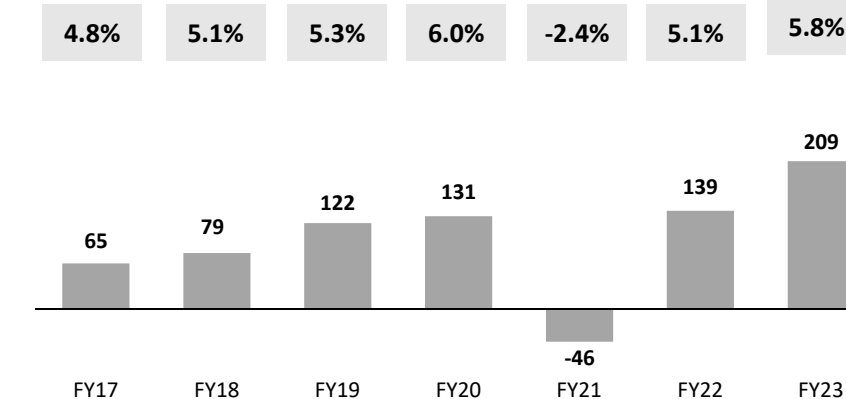
EBITDA (Rs. Crores) & EBITDA Margin

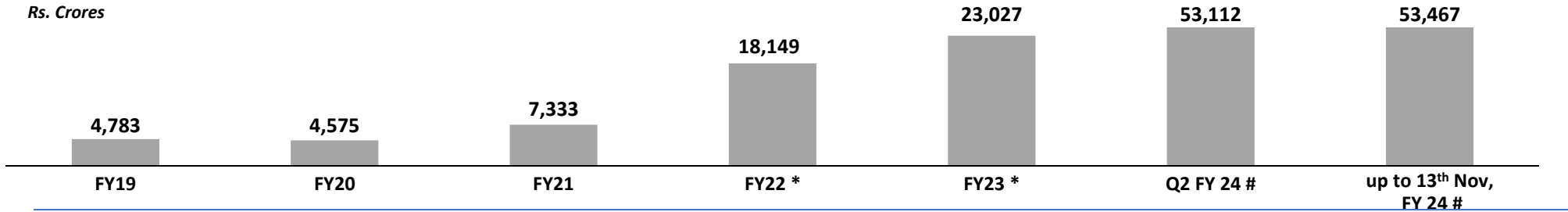

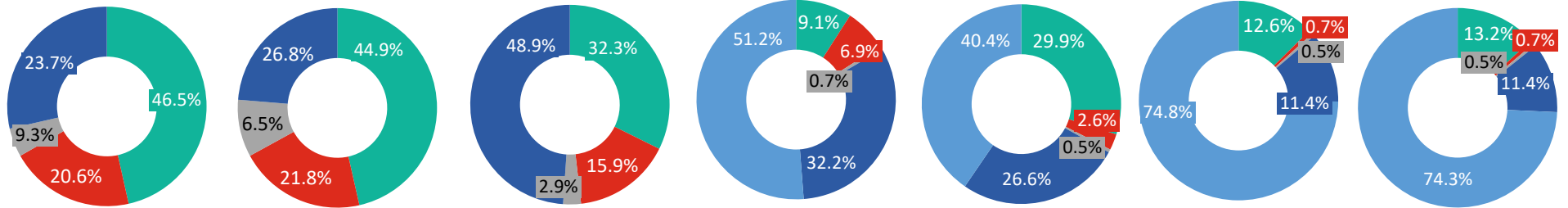

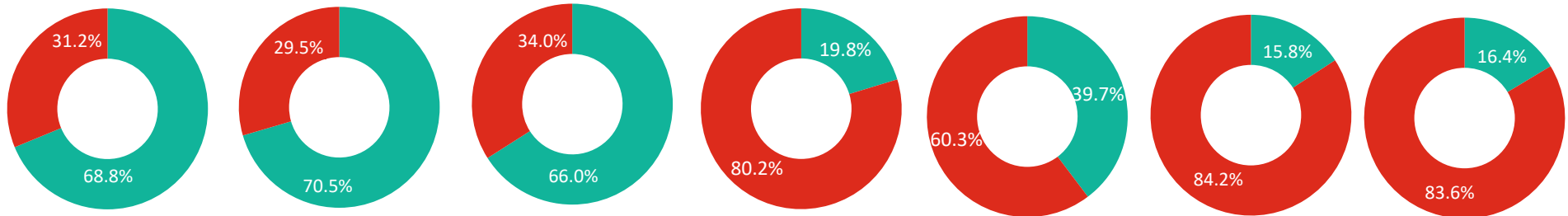
