Mumbai, Nov 14 (UNI) : Maharashtra opposition leader Ajit Pawar on Monday asked the government to withdraw the charges of molestation imposed against a NCP leader and former Minister Jitendra Awhad.

Imposition molestation clause on a public representative is a cowardly, he said.

Pawar also said that it is dangerous for Maharashtra to avoid important issues by creating such an environment.

However, he appealed to people to be vigilant if someone was working to defame the public representative and tarnish his image on the basis of the new laws that have been made without any reason, he added.

12K Sanglikars participated in Padyatra led by Mr Kadam

Hingoli, Nov 14 (UNI) Bharat Jodo Yatra was started on Monday morning in the presence of thousands of peoples from Sangli district led by former minister and MLA Vishwajit Kadam. The road was filled with a spontaneous crowd

of 12,000 Sanglikars wearing white t-shirts and white hats printed with symbols of the yatra.

Kadam himself participated in the Bharat Jodo Yatra to these workers from Palus-Kadegaon area.

After Sunday's rest,

Vaspangara in Kalmanuri yatra was left in the morning with vigor and enthusiasm. Photo exhibitions depicting Pandit Nehru's contribution to nation-building during the freedom struggle and post-independence were filled at some places.

The organizers said that in response to Nehru's constant defamation by the BJP, the contribution of the Nehru family to the country was shown.

To welcome Rahul Gandhi, his image was painted in a grand rangoli near the Collectorate of Hingoli. Rahul Swamy, an artist, said that he worked hard for 48 hours to paint the rangoli of Mr Gandhi.

At many other places, large rangolis were valso drawn on the road. There were rose flowers on the road. Where children stood with rose flowers and tricolor flags in their hands to receive them, in an atmosphere of great enthusiasm, the padyatris received a warm welcome in Hingoli on Children's Day. Pandit Nehru's image was worshiped and homage was paid at the place. Children wore Hindu, Muslim, Sikh, Christian costumes to convey the message of equality among all religions on this occasion.

A large number of state government employees joined the demand that the old pension should be restored. Doctor Dilip Lande, who came from Pune, had spread two quintals of flowers on the road. We are welcoming to padyatri's with rose flowers today on the occasion of Pandit Nehru's birth anniversary to support Rahul Gandhi's work of connecting the society, he said.

Kerala's 'Band Squad' is cynosure of all eyes in 'Bharat Jodo Yatra'

Hingoli, Nov 14 (UNI) : The "Svargadhara Band Squad" from Kerala which plays like a military march with bugles, drill tunes, clapping of tasha and 'left-right-left' in a very disciplined manner has become the center of attraction in 'Bharat Jodo Yatra'.

The 14-members band has a definite place and identity in Yatra. This team moves in front and the yatra moves in the same rhythm behind. As soon as the tune comes to the ears, the people standing in the village and square know that Rahul Gandhi's padayatra is near.

The band belongs to the Swargadhara Charitable Trust in Kerala. They perform many public and private ceremonies. The income received from the salary of the team's employees and the balance amount is given to poor children for education and medical assistance to the needy, said party sources.

The team has been given special training on the lines of the band team of the Navy. Sinoy, a retired naval officer, has given lessons in military discipline and conduct for five months. There is also a captain who leads the movement with a white uniform, black boots and a baton like the navy.

Three members including the captain and two prominent players accompany the entire yatra while the remaining members are changed every month. The team leader Sameer K said the long journey on foot and the disciplined movement with constant playing of musical instruments puts a lot of stress on the body, so a total of 30 people have been planned for the yatra, he said.

They are ready at the starting point of the padayatra at 5:30 in the morning. Within a few moments, Rahul Gandhi enters. Then the salute is given with the tune "Sare Jahan Se Achcha...." and the padayatra begins. The Yatra is punctuated by the tune of the National Anthem "Jan Gana Man...", added Mr Samir.
